

Hop Plants - Beer Brewing Information

If you are growing your Hop Plants with an eye to brewing beer come harvest season, please see below brewing information to help you make your choice.



Wye Challenger

A good all round hop. Crisp and fruity in character. Spicy, cedar, green tea aroma with sweet floral flavour notes. Alpha Acid Range 5% - 9% Flavour Intensity 7 /10

Fuggle

A well-known traditional English hop grown heavily in England after it was bred in the late 19th century. A delicate, minty slightly floral aroma hop. Alpha Acid Range 3% - 8% Flavour Intensity 4 /10

Goldings

A traditional aroma variety. Smooth, floral, slightly spicy and earthy. Good for late hopping ales when a delicate aroma is required.

Alpha Acid Range 4% - 7%

Flavour Intensity 4 /10

Prima Donna

The dwarf variety of First Gold. Growing to a maximum height of 3.5m. Ideal for all types of ales and lagers. Good aroma qualities and medium bittering potential. A rich citrus character with a slightly spicy note. Alpha Acid Range 5.6% - 8.7%
