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Assembly Instructions for Trestle Table

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Tools Needed: 9/16" Wrench/Socket, Measuring Tape, Phillips or Square Screw Driver

Before beginning assembly, please take a few moments to carefully read the instructions, familiarize yourself with the components and understand each step of the process. Likewise, please ensure that the hardware package contains the items as described below.

Parts List: (1) Table Top Assembly, (2) Leg Assemblies, (1) Center Cross Support Assembly

Hardware List: (16) 2" Screws, (4) 3" Lag Bolts, (4) Washers, (4) Wooden Plugs, (4) Leg Levelers

Assembly Instructions:

Step 1. Remove components from shipping boxes. You may lay the cardboard on the floor to prevent marring of finish.

Step 2. Lay table top face down on a soft, non-marring surface.

Step 3. Stand leg assemblies upright on the table. Ensure large diameter holes in leg assemblies are facing inward and the 2" x 6" mounting boards are flush against the table.

Step 4. Place center cross support into corresponding holes of leg assemblies. (An assistant is invaluable here!)

Step 5. Insert a lag bolt with washer into each pre-drilled hole on the leg assemblies and tighten.

Step 6. Using a tape measure, center the leg/cross support assembly on the table top ensuring the distance between the ends and sides are equal.

Step 7. Insert a 2" screw into each of the pre-drilled holes in the 2" x 6" mounting boards.

Step 8. Carefully tighten each of the sixteen 2" screws, securing the trestle base assembly to the table top.

Step 9. Insert leg levelers into each of the four leg adjusters located on the bottom of the leg assembly.

Step 10. Insert a wooden plug into each hole of the leg assembly.

Step 11. With the assistance of another person, turn table over. Raise or lower leg adjusters as needed.

PLEASE NOTE: If you purchased your item "ready to finish" special care must be taken to properly apply a high grade final finish in a timely manner. Doing so will help protect your purchase from discoloration and damage caused by exposure to ultra-violet light and/or weather. If the products intended use is outside, please use an exterior rated finish to also protect from weather damage. See use and care instructions for further information. Failure to adequately protect item by application and as needed, re-application of a final finish may void warranty.
