

Italian Mini Dictionary

To provide you with the maximum number of word possibilities, single letters, two-letter fragments and three-letter endings have been included in your kit. These fragments allow for the varying conjugations required by Italian grammar. In many cases, only the verb core has been given e.g. am (amare). The addition of any of several endings creates the correct grammatical form of the word e.g. amo, amerò. New words like chiamare (to call) and its forms can be made by combining the tiles (ch)(i)(am)(er)(ete). Some present tense conjugations of irregular verbs have been provided. Lots of fun for anyone who knows or is learning the Italian language!
