To provide you with the maximum number of word possibilities single letters and word fragments have been included in your kit to allow for the varying endings required by Spanish grammar. Only the verb core has been given i.e. am (amar). The addition of any of several endings creates the correct grammatical form of the word i.e. amo, amas, ama, aman. New words like desear (to desire, wish, want) and its forms can be made by combining three tiles (de) (se) (ar). Many possibilities equals lots of fun for anyone who knows or is learning the Spanish language!
