Operation Directions



1. Prepare Your Portable Hand Washing Sink

Two people should be used to remove the unit from the shipping box. Identify the included Mobi Soap Dispenser and optional Mobi Paper Towel Dispenser - set aside for later installation. Once upright, tighten eight (8) ½" bolts used with the brackets securing the gray water tank to the sink / fresh water tank - these bolts may have loosened during shipping. **DO NOT overtighten.**



2. Filling with Fresh Water

Unscrew the fill cap located at the top, left hand side of the wash basin. Insert a standard garden or similar type of hose / funnel and fill with a few gallons of fresh water to perform a system check. Depress the pump a few times to "prime" it. Continue filling the unit to desired water capacity level. The MOBI1-926 has a 17-gallon capacity. Tighten the cap when finished. **DO NOT transport the unit with water in the fresh water tank only.** In order to stabilize the unit for transportation with a full fresh water tank, water must also be added to the gray water tank. The unit can easily be transported when empty. Failure to follow these directions can void the product warranty.



3. Emptying Fresh Water

Drain the fresh water tank by unscrewing the white plug located at the bottom of the unit, to the left of the foot pump. Tighten the plug when finished



4. Emptying Gray Water

Wheel the sink to an approved drain location. Turn the red handle on the valve 90 degrees, away from the unit. Turn the handle back to the stationary position when finished.



5. Optional Paper Towel Dispenser

The optional paper towel dispenser can be mounted on the back side of the unit with the screws provided or on a wall, near the unit, as a stand-alone option. Mobi Sink recommends an 8" hardwound paper towel with a maximum length of 350 feet for use with the optional paper towel dispenser. Please see the BWK6252 Boardwalk Hardwound Paper Towels, 8" X 350Ft, 1-Ply Natural, 12 Rolls/Carton - BWK6252 on PortableHandWashing.Com.



6. Soap Dispenser

Mount the included MOBI Soap Dispenser at the top, right of the unit, on the sink side. Use the included screws (3) and the provided adhesive tape on the soap dispenser back-plate for the most secure installation. This unit holds 30 fluid ounces of bulk liquid soap.



7. Foot Pump Activation

To activate the unit, depress the foot pump. When the unit is first filled, you may need to depress the foot pump multiple times to get water pumping through the system. Once filled and primed, every time you step on the foot pump, water will then come out of the faucet.



8. Handle Transportation

To move the unit on the ground, use a firm grip and tip the unit onto the handle-side so that the full weight is supported by the wheels. Always use two hands when moving, pushing, pulling, or guiding the unit. **DO NOT transport the unit with water in the fresh water tank only.** In order to stabilize the unit for transportation with a full fresh water tank, water must also be added to the gray water tank. The unit can easily be transported when empty. Failure to follow these directions can void the product warranty.

9. Cleaning and Maintenance

Use a mild soap to clean all surfaces and component parts. Minor scratches and abrasions can be lightly sanded or scrubbed with a mild abrasive cleaner (such as "Soft Scrub") that contains calcium carbonate, hypochlorite bleach and detergents.
