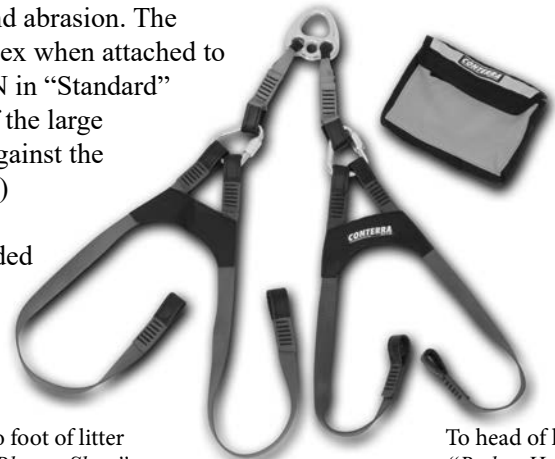


# Fix Litter Harness by Conterra

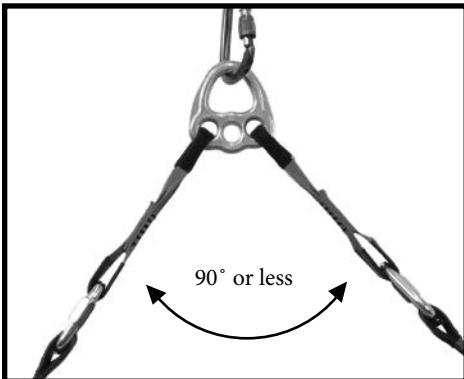
This litter harness is intended for general rescue. It is designed to be very compact and light weight. As a result, great care should be used to protect it from damage and abrasion. The strength of this harness is dependent upon the angle created at the litter apex when attached to a litter. The Fix Litter Harness has a theoretical breaking strength of 36 kN in “Standard” position of function with the apex of the harness at about 90°. Because of the large variance in litter dimensions, we recommend that the input force placed against the litter harness be less than 2.8 kN (approximately 280 kg in or on the litter)

A Dual Capability Two Tensioned Rope System (DCTTRS) is recommended when using this harness. For more information on DCTTRS systems, please refer to the Technical Rescue Riggers Guide by Rick Lipke.

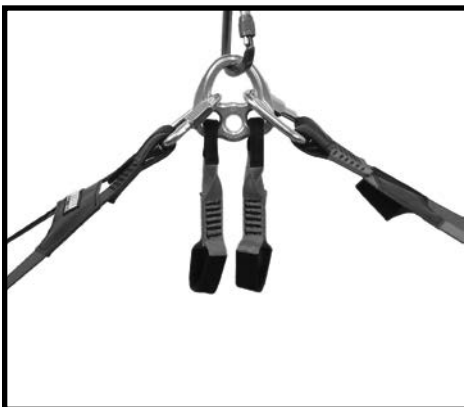


To foot of litter  
“Blue to Shoe”

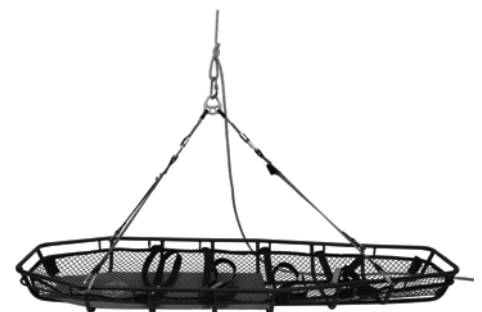
To head of litter  
“Red to Head”



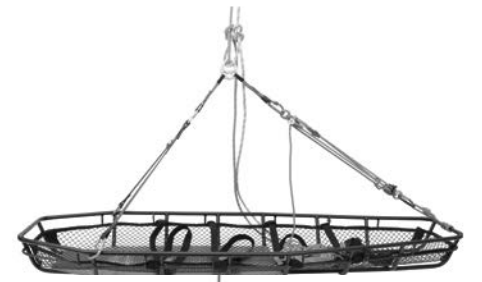
“Standard”

- It has been shock loaded (a fall of >1/2M with a stop distance of < 1/2M)
- The webbing is frayed
- The harness is dropped more than 3M
- The harness has come in contact with corrosives or petrochemicals
- The harness is ten years old
- The harness is used and/or left outdoors in daylight for more than 100 hrs
