- Operating temperature, 15 °F to 105 °F.

- Do not place the light face down while on for long periods of time as this will
 cause damage to surface and possible fire.
- Power Input only can be 5V-1A UL/ETL approved adapter. Do not use different power input adapter. This may cause damage to the product and may cause fire.

DERATING & CHARGING PROCEDURE

- CT1KWL Operating mode as below
 - Press the Power Button first time, top light switch on.
 - Press the Power Button second time, main light switch to Low mode.
 - Press the Power Button third time, main light switch to Medium mode.
 - Press the Power Button fourth time, main light switch to High mode.
 - Press the Power Button fifth time, all power off.
- Switch lamp off and connect with USB charger during charging.
- · The battery indicator will blink during charging.
- All the battery indicator lights will stay lit after finished charging.
- If the battery indicator did not light up, please remove the charger and try again.
- Always only use the charger recommended by CARNAGE TOOLS™ to charge the lamp. The use of a NON-recommended charger can lead to a fire and destroy the lamp.
- Before using the hand lamp for the first time, charge it for 4-5 hours.
- Fully charge the hand lamp before it is stored for a long period.

(!) SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not use the device if there is damage to the housing, plug or cable. Contact CARNAGE TOOLS™ Customer Service.
- Clean hand lamp only when the main plug is removed from the main power.
- There is a risk of short-circuit. Repairs on the device may only be carried out by CARNAGE TOOLS™ Technical Service.
- Protect the battery against heat, e. g., against continuous intense sunlight, fire, water, and moisture. Danger of explosion.
- If the battery is damaged or not used correctly, fluids can leak from the battery.
 Avoid contact with these. Leaking battery fluids can lead to skin irritation or burns. Rinse off with water if you should come into contact. If the fluid gets into your eyes, make sure you get medical help.
