

MAINTENANCE


TW Steel uses the best materials and carries out strict controls before the watch leaves the factory. How you wear or treat your TW Steel will determine whether the appearance of the watch is maintained in the future, or whether it will deteriorate.

To enjoy wearing your TW Steel as long as possible, we've included a number of tips in this manual. If the watch comes into contact with hard or corrosive materials, this can cause damage, which, if it occurs regularly, will become clearly visible in the form of scratches.

The watch is a precision mechanical instrument and should be treated as such. Adjusting the time or date, opening or closing the crown or crown cap, should not be done roughly, but carefully.

USE OF THE CROWN

To adjust the time, unscrew the crown anti-clockwise and pull the crown out. Once you have set the time, push the crown back to its normal position and screw the crown clockwise back to the case.



ADJUSTING THE TIME

Normal Position (A)

Unscrew the crown and pull the crown to the **B** position.

Turn the crown to set the hour and minute hands.

Push the crown back to the A position and screw in the crown.

WIND UP THE MAINSPRING

Normal Position (A)

Unscrew the crown and turn the crown clockwise to wind up the mainspring. Wind 15 ~20 times clockwise until second hand starts to move naturally.

CAUTION: IF THE CROWN IS NOT PRESSED OR SCREWED IN PROPERLY, THE WATCH
IS NO LONGER WATER RESISTANT AND THE MOVEMENT CAN BE SERIOUSLY DAMAGED!

Temperature

Do not expose your watch to sudden temperature changes (exposure to sunlight followed by immersion in cold water) or extreme temperatures [over 60°C (140°F) or below 0°C (32°F)].

Shocks

Avoid thermal or other shocks as it may harm your watch. In the event of a violent shock please have your watch checked by a reputable jeweler.

Harmful Products

Avoid direct contact with solvents, detergents, and perfumes, cosmetic products, etc. since they may damage the bracelet, the case and/or the gaskets.

Care and Checks

Your watch should be cleaned with a soft cotton cloth that is not impregnated with any cleaning material. It is advisable to polish your watch with a soft cotton cloth regularly. All water resistant watches can be cleaned with a toothbrush and soapy water, and then dried with a soft cloth. After being worn in the sea, the watch must be rinsed with warm fresh water, and then dried completely.

Replacing the Battery

(For Quartz watches only)
We recommend you take the watch to a reputable jeweler or watch repair facility who is equipped with the tools and apparatus required to carry out the work and the necessary checks in a professional manner. A worn-out battery should be replaced immediately in order to reduce the risk of leakage and consequent damage to the movement.

Water Resistance

- 1. [5atm / 50m / 165ft]
 Watches water resistant from 50 meters / 165 feet.
- 2. [10atm / 100m / 330ft]
 Watches water resistant from 100 meters / 330 feet.
- 3. **[20atm / 200m / 660ft]**Watches water resistant from 200 meters / 660 feet.

According to the water resistance 1, 2 or 3 listed above, watches are protected against:

- 1-2-3 Water splashes / Rain
- 1-2-3 Surface swimming
- 1-2-3 Shower
 - 2-3 Free diving / Water sports
 - 3 Scuba diving of the surface

Limited Warranty

Your TW STEEL watch is warrantied by TW STEEL for a period of TWELVE (12) MONTHS from the date of purchase under the terms and conditions of this warranty. The international TW STEEL warranty covers material and manufacturing defects. The warranty only becomes active if the warranty certificate is dated, fully and correctly completed. In the event that repairs are improper to restore the normal conditions of use of your TW STEEL watch, TW STEEL guarantees its replacement by a TW STEEL watch of identical or similar characteristics. The warranty for the replacement watch is TWELVE (12) MONTHS after the date the replacement is issued.

This manufacturer's warranty does not cover:

- 1. The life of the battery
- 2. Wear and tear and aging (e.g. scratched crystal; alteration of the color and/or material of non metallic straps and chains, such as leather, textile, rubber; peeling of the plating).
- 3. Any damage on any part of the watch resulting from abnormal/abusive use, lack of care, negligence, and accidents (nicks, dents, crushing, broken crystal, etc.). Incorrect use of the watch and non-observance of the use directions provided by TW STEEL. The TW STEEL watch not handled by a reputable jeweler (e.g., for battery replacement, services or repairs) or which has been altered in its original condition beyond TW STEEL's control.
