Lesson 2	To be able to use paper to create a collage.	Children to explore and learn about different types of collages. Lesson 3	To be able to work with tissue paper to create a piece of artwork.	Children to explore and describe what tissue paper is. They will learn about stained glass windows and re-create their own version of a stained glass window using tissue paper.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do children know what stained glass is and where it is commonly used? Can children work with tissue paper to create a stained glass effect? Lesson 4	To be able to use paper to create beads.	Children to describe and discuss what beads are and what they are used for. They will learn how to make beads using paper and can enjoy creating bracelets or key rings with their hand-made paper beads.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do children know how beads are used to make objects? Can children work with paper to create beads? Lesson 5	To be able to use papier mâché to create a sculpture.	Children to describe and discuss what papier mâché is and how it can be used. They will have fun creating their own papier mâché sculptures using recycled materials.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can children explain what papier mâché is and how it is used by artists? Can children work with papier mâché to create a model? Lesson 6	To be able to create sculptures from paper.	Children will be looking at famous sculptors and discussing their works of art.
