Lesson 1	To compare and contrast Spain and the United Kingdom	In this first lesson, children will share what they already know about the UK and Spain. As a class, children will look at a range of pictures of Spain and discuss what this tells them about the country, including how similar or different it is to the UK. In the independent activity, they sort picture and information cards into two piles depending on which country they represent.	 Can children identify pictures of and facts about Spain? Lesson 2	To know where Spain is in the world	Children begin by finding Spain on a world map. They then look in more detail at the country, and find out about the location of its autonomous communities, the bordering countries, seas and oceans, as well as the island groups that are part of Spain. Children record what they have learnt on their own maps of Spain.	 Can children locate Spain on a world map? Can children locate and label regions, cities, oceans and seas on a map of Spain? Lesson 3	To know about the physical geography of Spain	Children will recap on their knowledge of Spain so far, before finding out more about the physical geography of the country, including its coastlines, rivers and mountainous regions. In their independent work, they will research and create a booklet about the Pyrenees, or alternatively, write an account about a hiking trip through the mountains.	 Do children know what physical geography is? Can children locate the coastal and mountainous areas of Spain on a map? Can children use some geographical vocabulary to describe the physical attributes of an area? Lesson 4	To know about the human geography of Spain	In this lesson, children will find out about the human geography of Spain. In groups, they will research and prepare a short presentation for the rest of the class on different aspects of Spanish culture; food, festivals, music and dance, famous buildings and Madrid.	 Do children understand the term 'human geography'? Can children use resources to research the human geography of Spain? Can children describe some aspects of the human geography of Spain? Lesson 5	To know about the region of Catalonia	Children will find out more about the autonomous community of Catalonia, and how some Catalons want independence from the rest of Spain. Children will discuss some of the reasons for and against this. In the independent activity, they will sort statement cards according to whether they are for or against Catalon independence. Children will share their own views and opinions based on what they have learnt.	 Do children know what an autonomous community is? Do children know some of the reasons why Catalonia wants to be independent from Spain? Can children discuss some advantages and disadvantages of Catalonia becoming independent from Spain? Lesson 6	To find out about the climate of Spain	Children will briefly recap on the physical and human geography of Spain, before moving on to explore the difference between weather and climate. They will learn about the three main climate zones of Spain, and map them on their own map. In the alternate activity, children will match up climate fact cards with temperature, rainfall and sunshine charts for the three different regions.	Do children understand the difference between weather and climate? Can children identify the different climate zones on a map of Spain? Can children describe the different climate zones of Spain? Lesson 7	To understand the importance of tourism to Spain	In this lesson, children will understand the terms 'tourist' and 'tourism'. They will begin to discuss the advantages and disadvantages tourism can bring to a country. Children will use the knowledge they have gained about Spain so far to create a persuasive advertisement or roleplay designed to entice tourists to visit.	Do children know what tourism is?
