







## CHAIR WITH 3 PILLOWS



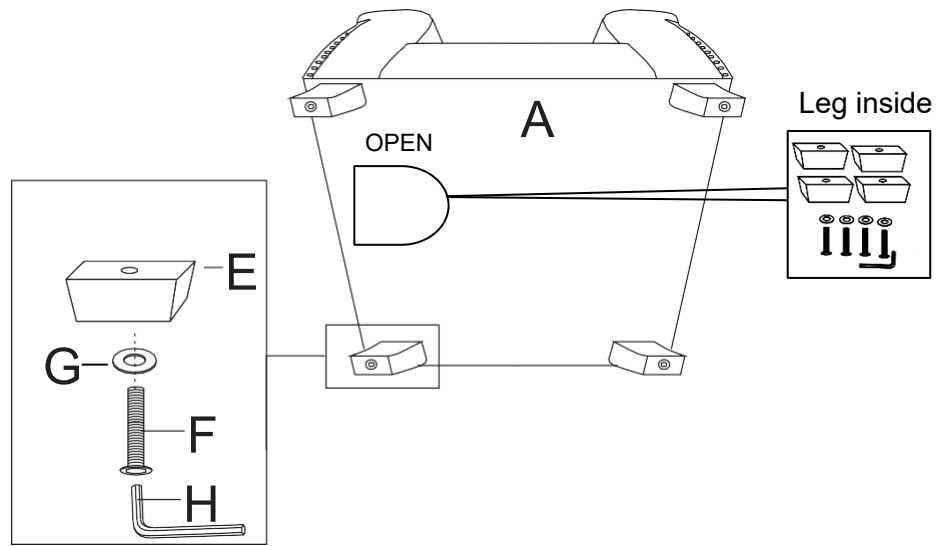
Legs and hardware are stored at the bottom of chair, please take out the legs and hardware for assembly.

**NOTE:** Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which leads to splitting or cracking the wood.

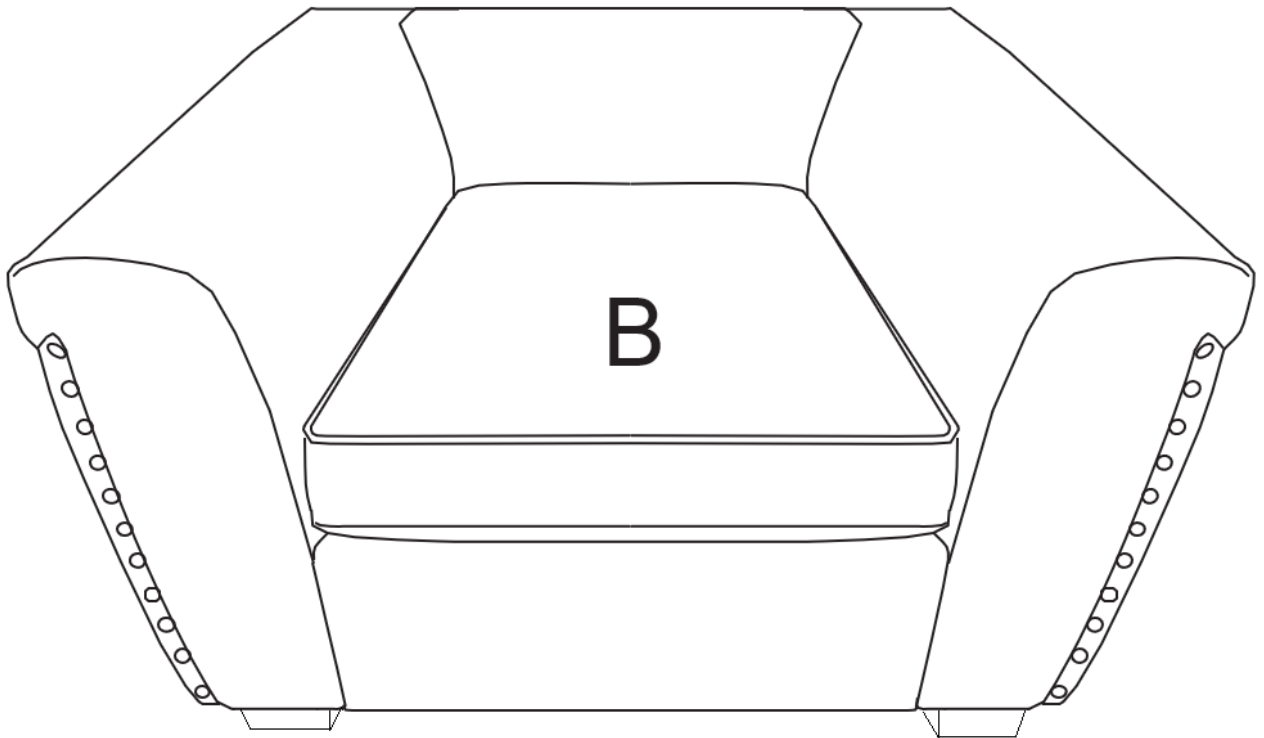









### LOVE SEAT WITH 6 PILLOWS



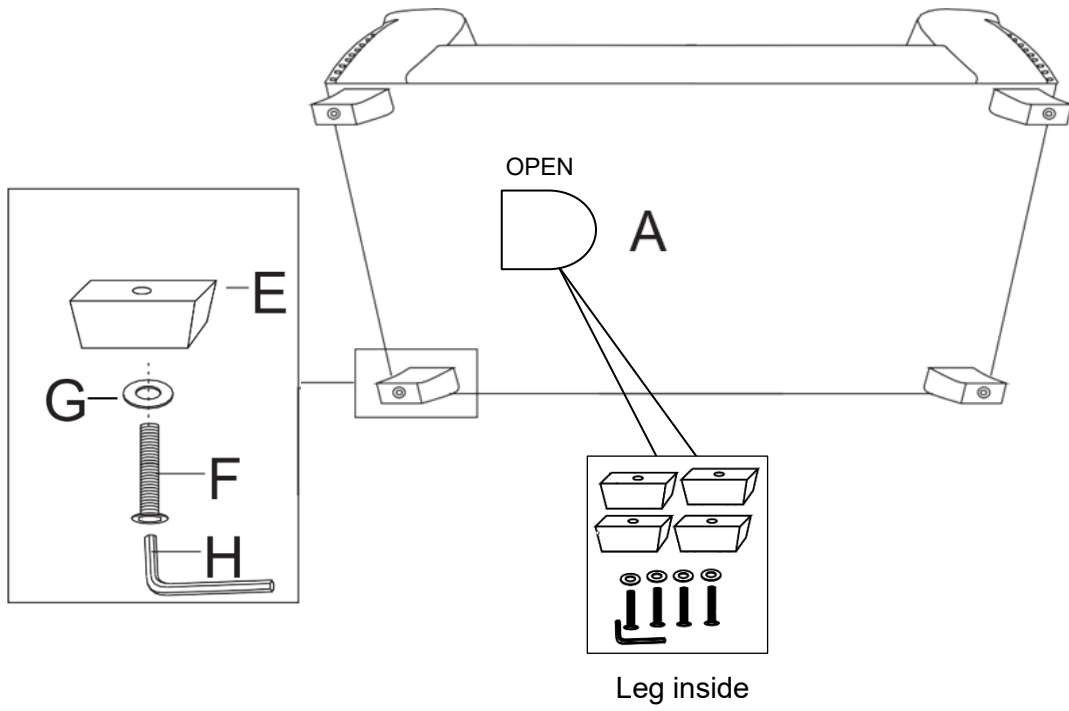
Legs and hardware are stored at the bottom of love seat, please take out the legs and hardware for assembly.

**NOTE:** Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which leads to splitting or cracking the wood.

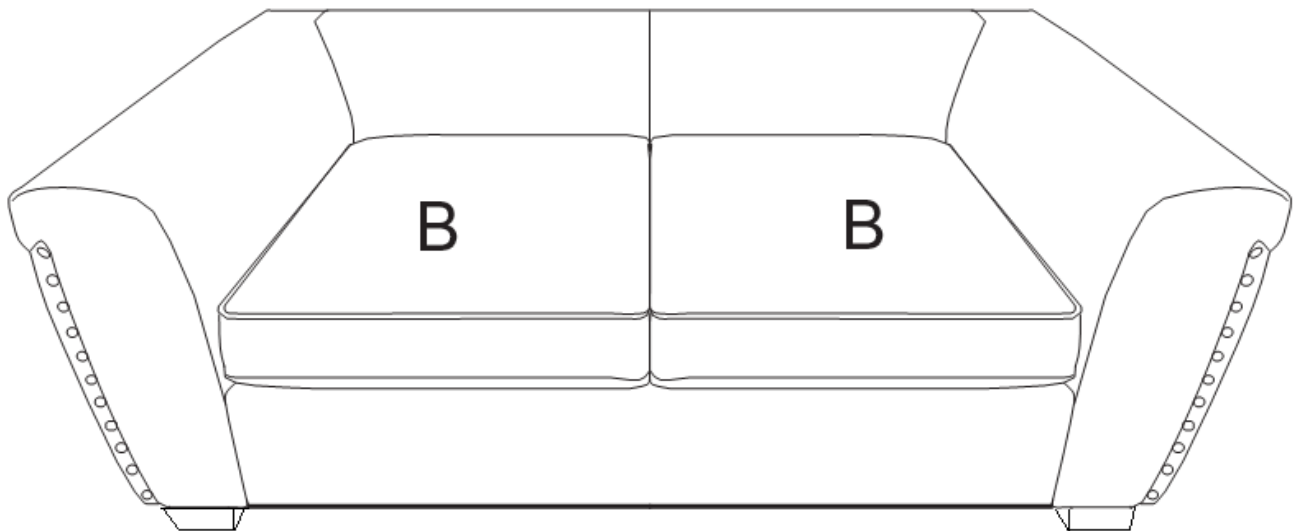
