
McLeod Park Campground Recommendations and notes

Site Recommendations

Our favorite, R7 is secluded compared to other sites, it's also waterfront on the lakeside with the river just a walk across the street. It's also next to a wooded area and great for gathering firewood. Future sites are scheduled to be put in across the street, but as of March 2020, they haven't been.

60,61- waterfront and next to floating dock and boat launch, large parking lot across road. Wooded areas also nearby for gathering firewood.

62-71 Rockpile row offers a great view overlooking the river, the end sites offer some seclusion and are great for groups looking for multiple sites

37 to 40 – Any combinations of these sites would be good for large groups as you somewhat have the peninsula to yourself.

40-58 are all waterfront and offer wooded areas nearby for gathering firewood.

R19 & R20 waterfront with sandbar and slightly larger than other sites, trail between the two offers beach access to others

R20-31 seem to have a little more room than R8-R18 on the opposite side.

Green text 118-134 have less shade and are reservation only.

Most of the sites 12-143 in red text have relatively good shade from large oaks.

56 and 79 are the only pull through sites available.
