



MEASURING INSTRUCTIONS


Since Viberg uses UK sizes, foot tracing is the best way to ensure the right size. Please follow the instructions carefully.

We recommend that you are seated comfortably with your knee bent slightly forward. Using a pencil, have another person trace around your foot. For accuracy, do not trace your own foot. Make sure the pencil stays perfectly upright at all times.

What is your	US boot size?	
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STEP ONE

Wearing the same thickness socks you intend to wear with your boots, place your foot on a plain piece of paper. Have your helper trace the outline, keeping the pencil straight up.



Identify the longest point from heel to toe and measure the length. Identify the widest point at the ball of foot and measure width, then measure the width at the narrowest point of the heel. (measurements in inches are preferred)

If you generally fit a standard size well, then these measurements are all you need to send. However, if you find that normal fitting is difficult due to foot shape, high instep, or orthotic device, then please also complete the following steps.


STEP TWO

Using a fabric measuring tape, measure the circumference at the ball of foot.

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
STEP THREE

Measure the circumference at the instep.




STEP FOUR


Measure the circumference at the heel.



STEP FIVE

Measure the circumference at the calf, at the highest point the boot will touch.





Measure in a straight line across the longest/ widest axis.
