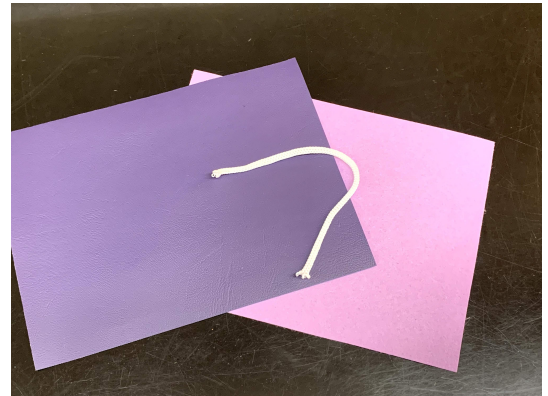




Signs, Door Hangers, & Ornaments Tutorial

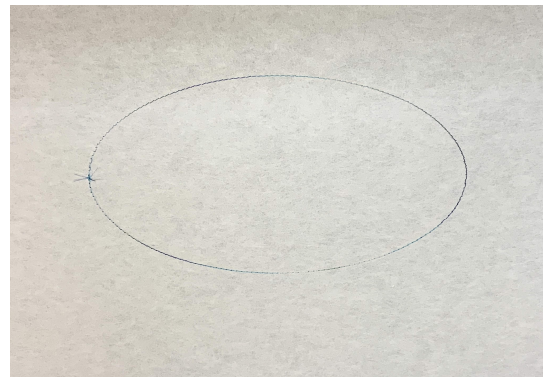
I grouped these together because they're all essentially made the same way. The ornaments are a small version of the signs and the door hangers have no string and just need the relevant parts cut out.

Materials - Vinyl or felt cut to the appropriate size
String - about 6 inches
(can be ribbon, twine, or even an old shoelace!)
Tearaway Stabilizer
Matching bobbin



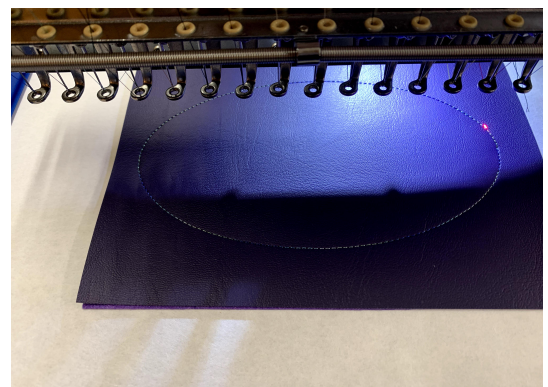
Step 1

Hoop tearaway and stitch placement.
If design doesn't have one you can run the first color twice.



Step 2

Float top fabric and run the tackdown.
If your fabric won't behave you can tape it down or use spray adhesive. I personally don't care for the spray stuff, but to each their own. Just be sure to keep tape out of the stitch area.



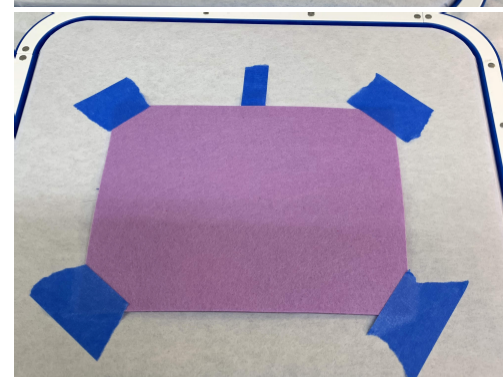
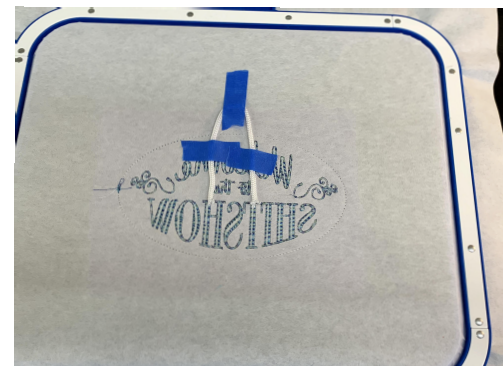
Step 3

Stitch the main design until you get to the back fabric tackdown step.



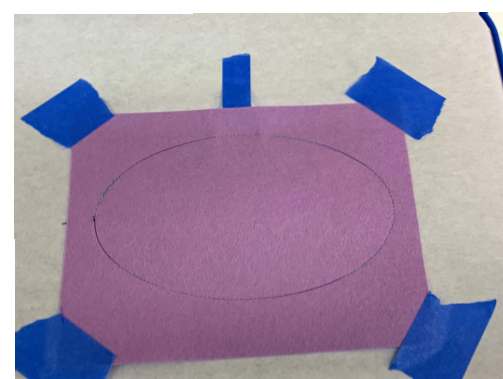
Step 4

Remove hoop from machine and turn it over. On the back use painters tape to position the hanger/string making sure to have enough above the stitchline. Then attach the back fabric (again, using tape) on top of that. Make sure to cover all stitch areas!



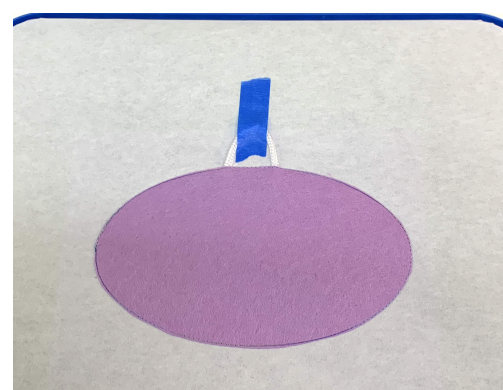
Step 5

Stitch tackdown and remove hoop from machine.



Step 6

Trim all fabric (front & back) as close as possible to the stitchline. Make sure you **DO NOT CUT** the hanger/string.

Step 7

Replace on the machine and stitch the final satin. You could have just one or you could have a satin then a decorative stitch. Depends on the design. Now you're finished! Remove from the stabilizer and trim any jumps. Enjoy!
