## Frequently asked Questions

Appetite Aid is a healthy, all-natural way to enhance the appetite of ill or finicky pets, encouraging them to eat their food. Also a handy tool for assisting pets with the transition from dry, crunchy food to the softer texture of raw food.

#### What are the ingredients?

Appetite Aid may contain any combination of the following: Beef Lung, Chicken Breast, Fish. These are the same ingredients found in our other treats.

#### Is it organic?

All our meats are purchased from companies that sell meats for human consumption. The meats are not certified organic, but are from animals that are free range, humanely raised and killed, non-medicated (no growth hormones or antibiotics), and USDA inspected. All except the lungs are graded for human use.

#### Is it fattening?

No, Appetite Aid is protein-based and the ingredients are all quite lean.

#### How do I know how much to use?

This depends on your situation and not on the age or weight of your pet. A liberal "shake" over the food should do the trick, or you may also mix the Appetite Aid into the food instead/in addition. It is best to start small and gradually add more if needed. Use the amount necessary to get the job done.

#### Do I have to use it on every meal?

Your pet will answer this for you. If he eats his food willingly, you may not need to use Appetite Aid anymore, but if he still hesitates, you probably need to keep using it.

### Can too much hurt my pets?

No, too much will not cause harm. However, it is not suggested to use this product to the extent that it is replacing your pet's regular food. It is meant to encourage eating, but by itself it is not a stand alone diet.

#### Will my pet get "hooked" on this stuff?

No. Your pet may become fond of this product, but it contains no chemicals, drugs, or anything of an addictive nature to cause dependency.
