

# HEMINGWAY – 3 Light Floor lamp

## Model No.: 19604

Before first using your new Floor Lamp it is most important that you read and follow these instructions, even if you feel you are quite familiar with this type of product. Keep this document in a safe place for future reference.

### For your safety

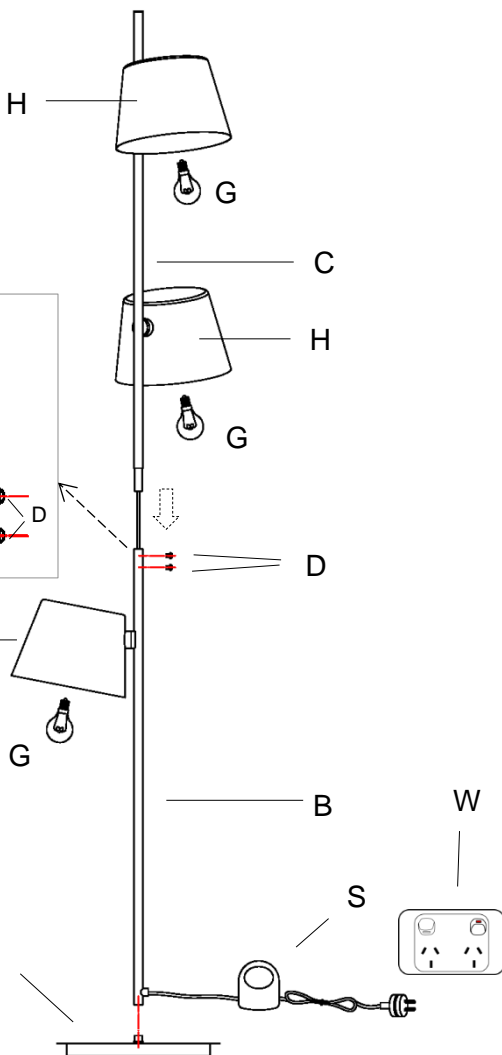
- To prevent electric shock ensure that power is OFF and UNPLUGGED before removing or inserting the light bulb.
- During use, the light bulb and/or light assembly becomes hot. To prevent burns do not touch the globe or any parts of the assembly with bare hands when it is hot.
- Do not install in a position where the fitting can be easily accessed by children or the infirm.
- Do not touch any part of the assembly with bare hands while it is 'ON'.

### INSTRUCTIONS

- Carefully unpack the fitting and dispose of the packaging material thoughtfully.
  - Ensure the product is not plugged into wall outlet at this stage.
- 1) Place the light fitting on the flat and soft surface.
  - 2) Align rod 'B' with thread on base 'A' and screw base 'A' to the metal rod 'B'. Tighten firmly.
  - 3) Align then gently push rod 'C' into rod 'B' and carefully feed the excess cable into the metal stem. Ensure not to damage the cable in this process.
  - 4) Align the screw holes in rod 'C' with holes in rod 'B' and apply screws 'D' to hold them firmly together.
  - 5) Insert an E14 type globe 'G' (not supplied) into each lampholder. Do not exceed the maximum recommended wattage.
  - 6) Adjust the head 'H' into desired direction. Note: The heads 'H' can be rotated left or right only.
  - 7) Plug the cord into the selected wall socket 'W' and turn the wall socket 'ON'.
  - 8) Operate this floor lamp by using the in-line switch 'S' located on the cord.

### CAUTIONS

- Always use this fitting fully assembled with all parts attached and well tightened.
- During use the light globe will become hot.
- Do not place any object on the top of the metal head 'H'.
- Do not operate this fitting when flammable materials such as curtains or blinds can come in contact with the head or the globe.
- Do not touch the globe with bare hands while it is on. Always wait until it cools down before replacement.
- Do not operate in a position where children or infirm persons can access the fitting.
- Do not exceed maximum wattage.
- Prior to cleaning, switch off the power. Only clean by using a soft cloth, do not use chemicals.
