1) Amazon Rainforest

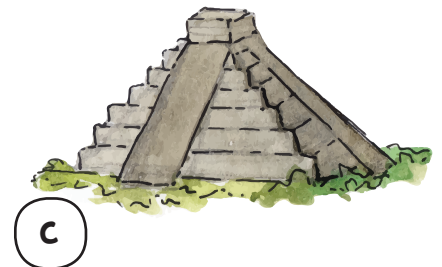

Coffee production in Colombia has a reputation for producing mild, well balanced coffee beans. Colombia's average annual coffee production is the third total highest in the world, after Brazil and Vietnam; though highest in terms of the arabica bean.

1) Matryoshka Dolls

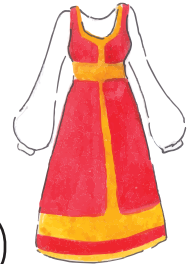
A matryoshka doll, also known as a Russian nesting doll, stacking dolls, or Russian doll is a set of wooden dolls of decreasing size placed one inside another.

3) Sarafan

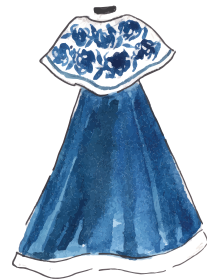
A sarafan is a long, trapezoidal traditional jumper dress (pinafore) worn as folk costume by Russian women and girls.

1) Safari

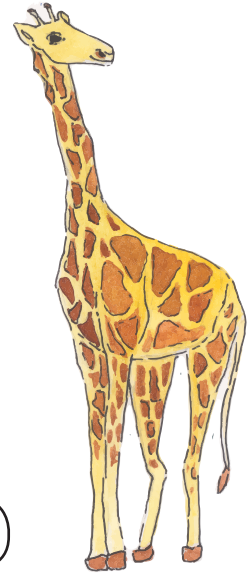
Kenya is renowned for its remarkable diversity of landscapes, animals and cultures, providing a striking backdrop for Africa's most classic safari adventures.

3) Giraffes

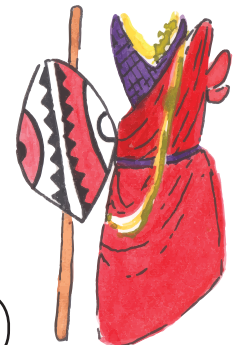

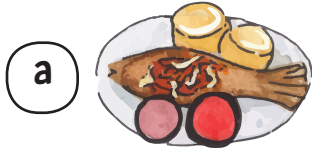

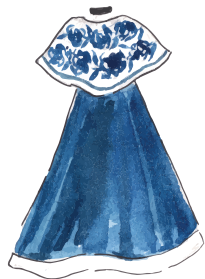
