Vinyl sticker application

Your decal is made of high quality fade resistant, 3 - 5 year guaranteed vinyl. This product works best on a **SMOOTH** surface. We do not recommend sticking them on rough walls. It can be more easily removed when heated with a hair dryer, but cannot be reused.

Please note that only some of the stickers have transfer tape /application sheet on as it is not necessary with the peel and stick designs.

When sticking bigger designs like trees, please remember to overlap the separate pieces by a few millimeters to prevent lines showing where the wall comes through.

With all of our decals, there is no background and the surface it is applied to will show through!

Think of your vinyl stickers in 3D. Your sticker works as a sheet of 3 layers:


- 1. Top layer **Transfer tape**: this will either be already on top of your vinyl or will come in a separate roll for you to apply. Please note that you have to reuse it for all the separate pieces.
- 2. Middle layer Vinyl
- 3. Bottom layer Backing paper




Preparation: Use a wet cloth to clean your surface. Surface must be clean of all dirt, dust, oil etc! Let your surface dry.

You can cut your design in smaller pieces to make it easier to stick or arrange on your wall as some designs have been arrange to fit on the sheet and are not in the correct positions.

Remove backing: Flip the decal sheet around and slowly peel off the bottom layer. Best when working from one corner to opposite corner at an angle. If the decal wants to stick to the backing paper, slowly manipulate the bottom layer to help decal stick to the transfer tape.



Position: Position your decal on your desired surface.





Rub onto surface: Use your bank/credit card to firmly rub over the top layer to secure your decal to the surface. Be sure to work from the centre out into all directions. Leave it for a minute to help release the adhesive from the transfer sheet.



Peel off transfer tape: Carefully and slowly peel off the top layer to reveal your decal. (Best when working from a top corner to the bottom of the opposite end. If part of the decal starts to come up with the transfer tape, rub it back down while tape is still on. Any air bubbles can be removed by poking a small hole in the vinyl with a needle or pin and pushing the air out with your finger.

Please note: Do not wash your surface with the newly applied stickers for at least 7 days and press down any lifting corner until the glue settles.

Removal: When it comes time to remove your vinyl stickers, remember that the heat of a hair dryer will help soften the vinyl. This makes it easier to remove. Then simply clean your surface with household cleaner or alcohol.

Tips

- Use a hair dryer when applying and removing the vinyl, especially in cold weather. The heat makes the glue stick & release better.
- Fantastick does not recommend using our products on Rhinolited walls and/or dry-walling as this will damage the paint once the vinyls are removed.
- Wait at least 2 weeks before applying your stickers to newly painted walls as the chemicals will damage the vinyl.
