# **Assembly Instructions**

## 20th c. Americana Iron Platform Bed by HEIRESSY

### Pre-Assembly – Remove Staples from the box before removing the bed to prevent scratches.

- 1. Read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- 2. Two people are recommended for assembly.
- 3. Tools required
  - a. Philips screwdriver
  - b. 7/16" wrench or adjustable wrench

#### **Parts Included:**

Qtv 1 - Headboard

Qty 1 - Footboard

Qty 2 - Side Rails

Qty 3 - Metal Crossbars

Qty 1 - Metal Vertical Center Support with 2 Legs

Qty 1 - Slat Roll with Black Fabric Covering Wood Slats



(A) Qty 10 Hex Bolts 1/4"-20 x 1"

(B) Qty 8 Washers 1/4"-20 x 1"

(C) Qty 6 Philips Flathead Bolts ¼"-20 x 1"

(D) Qty 6 Serrated Nuts 1/2"-20

## Instructions: Hand tighten only until last step

- (1) Determine the location for the bed and place headboard in the upright position.
- (2) Attach and side rails to the headboard using 2 Washers (B) and 2 Hex Bolts (A) in each post. The Hex Bolt first goes through the washer, then the side rail bracket hole, then into the headboard.
- (3) Attach side rails to the footboard using 2 Washers (B) and 2 Hex Bolts (A) in each post.
- (4) Attach crossbars to the side rails using 1 Philips Flathead Bolt and 1 Serrated Nut on each end. The Philips Flathead Bolt (C) should go through the side rail and crossbars, with the Serrated Nuts (D) on bottom.
- (5) Attach vertical center bar to the 3 crossbars using Philips Flathead Bolts and Serrated Nuts
- (6) The vertical center bar has a threaded insert at each end to bolt the first and last slat in position. Place platform slat roll near headboard and attached the center of the first slat to vertical center bar using a Washer (B), a Hex Bolt (A) and the threaded inserts at the end of the vertical center bar. Unroll the fabric covered wood slats toward the footboard and bolt the last slat to the vertical center bar.
- (7) Fully tighten all bolts. Do not over-tighten.

#### Maintenance:

- Periodically re-tighten all bolts
- Clean using a soft cloth, dry or slightly damp. Do not use harsh cleaners or abrasives.
