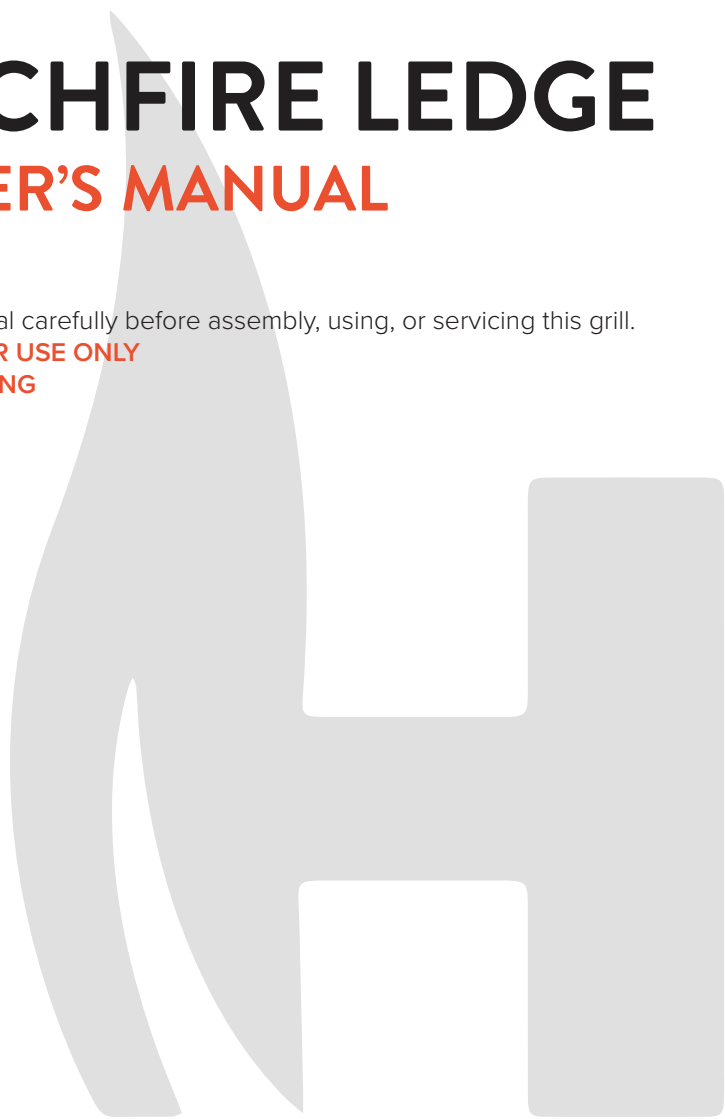

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Slide the swing away arm assembly into your hitch and secure it with the hitch stabilizer bolt
 - A. Tighten the bolt using a wrench, make sure to tighten the bolt all the way through to the other side of the hitch, slide the cotter pin into the bolt.
2. Pull out and twist the hinge spring lock. ‘
 - A. Release the slam-latch by pressing down on the lever.
3. Swing the arm away from the vehicle and lock at 90 degree position for stability. Place the Ledge platform onto the arm.
4. Clamp the quick release lever to secure the Ledge platform.
5. Lock the ledge platform head onto the arm with a padlock. (Not included)
6. Swing the arm closed, pushing towards the vehicle until the slam-latch is fully engaged.
7. Rotate the hinge spring lock to engage the plunger.

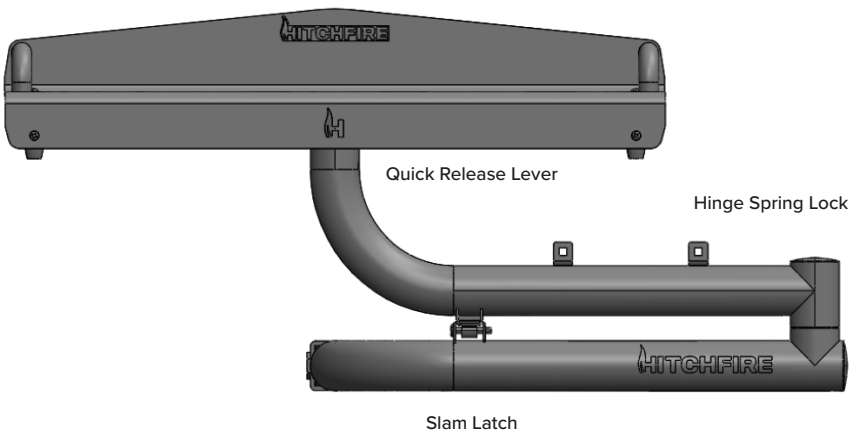
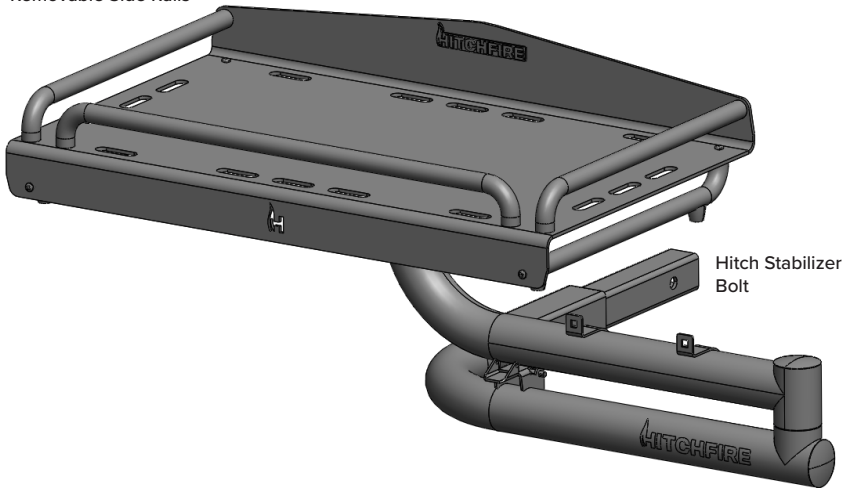
Use of phillips or flat head screw driver can be utilized to remove side rails to allow for larger

***The maximum allowable weight on the Ledge is 100 lbs when used with an adequate hitch receiver. Please consult your vehicle user manual to confirm Class III hitch classification.

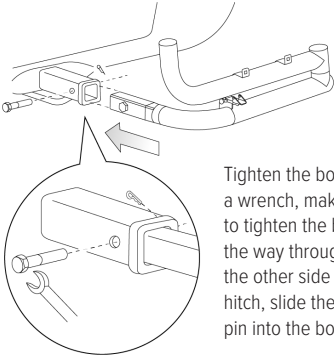


Removable Side Rails



ASSEMBLY - ATTACHING THE GRILL

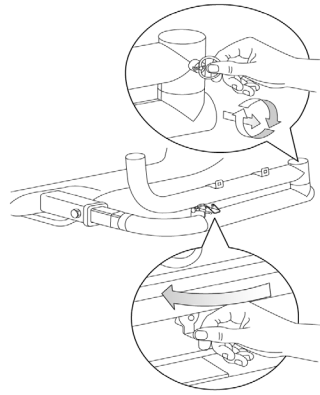
- 1** Slide the swing away arm assembly into your hitch and secure it with the hitch stabilizer bolt.



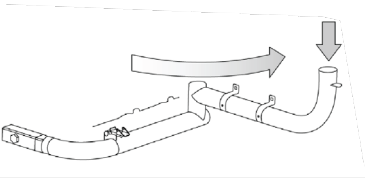
Tighten the bolt using a wrench, make sure to tighten the bolt all the way through to the other side of the hitch, slide the cotter pin into the bolt.

⚠ DO NOT MOVE VEHICLE UNLESS THE SWING AWAY ARM ASSEMBLY IS SECURELY BOLTED ONTO THE HITCH.

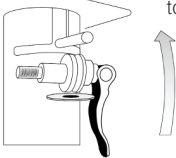
- 2** **A.** Pull out and twist the hinge spring lock.
B. Release the slam-latch by pressing down on the lever.



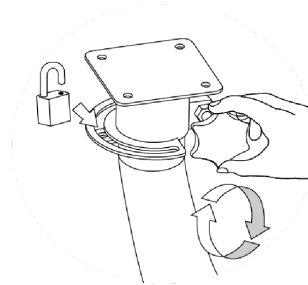
- 3** Swing the arm away from the vehicle and lock at the 90 degree position for stability. Place the Ledge platform onto the arm.



- 4** Clamp the quick release lever to secure the grill to the arm.



- 5** Lock the ledge onto the arm with a padlock. (Not included.)

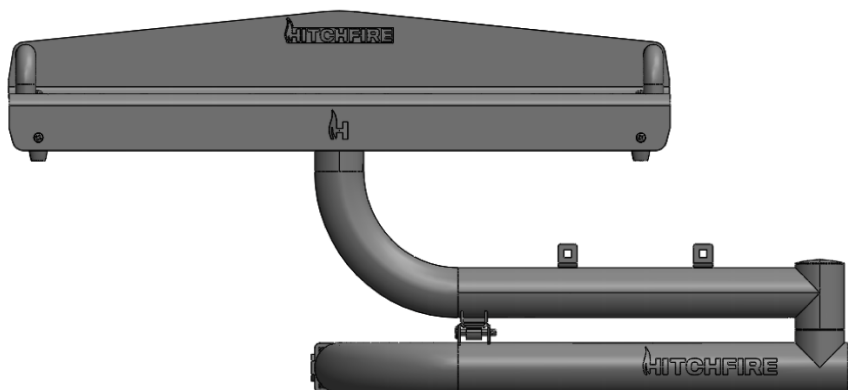


⚠ DO NOT MOVE VEHICLE UNLESS THE LEDGE IS LOCKED IN PLACE.



- 6 Swing the arm closed, pushing towards the vehicle until the slam-latch is fully engaged.
- 7 Rotate the hinge spring lock to engage the plunger.
- 8 Close hinge spring lock and slam-latch.

⚠ DO NOT MOVE VEHICLE UNLESS THE HINGE SPRING LOCK & SLAM-LATCH ARE SECURE.

Deterioration or damage due to severe weather conditions such as hail, hurricanes, earthquakes, or tornadoes including rust, discoloration due to exposure to chemicals (including salt) either directly or in the atmosphere, or very high humidity, is not covered by this limited Warranty.

THERE ARE NO OTHER EXPRESS WARRANTIES BEYOND THE TERMS OF THIS LIMITED WARRANTY. IN NO EVENT SHALL HitchFire BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.
