

TROUBLE SHOOTING LEAKING & POOR PRESSURE

- 1. Always check for leaks when you install clean filter cartridges.
- 2. Use smear of rubber grease to help sealing & stop 'O' ring kinking on both filter housing 1uM & 5uM
- 3. Check 'O' is not stuck in black lid
- 4. Use a smear rubber grease on all hose fittings that have rubber 'O' rings
- 5. Check inline filter near control box squeeze sides and pull up clear top rinse off any product on filter mesh & smear rubber grease in top to help sealing and stop kinking push clear top onto black base it snaps shut.
- 6. As the system uses a pressure pump any leaking will cause lack of pressure.
- 7. Remember to replace back cover NO cover system will not work.
