




Standard Mounting Inboard of Oar Tower




Offset Mounting Inboard of Oar Tower

Dropdown Mounting Outboard of Oar Tower




BEFORE ASSEMBLING THE SWIFTCAST DETERMINE YOUR PREFERRED MOUNTING OPTION (SEE PREVIOUS PAGE). USE ORANGE RUBBER SPACERS WITHIN UNIVERSAL MOUNTING BRACKETS WHEN ATTACHING THE SWIFTCAST TO FRAMES THAT ARE 1.625" OUTSIDE DIAMETER OR SMALLER.

## STEP 1

Prepare Parts For Assembly - DO NOT ASSEMBLE SWIFTCAST HALVES UNTIL STEP 4

- 1
- Pre-assemble slot hardware (Slot Bolt & Nut) onto Reel Box, Nose Cone, and Channel Connector
  - Fasteners should be loose, the nuts should be threaded on 2-3 threads. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN.




Attach Nose Cone and Reel Box onto Channel Extrusions - DO NOT ASSEMBLE SWIFTCAST HALVES UNTIL STEP 4



Slide the Reel Box and Nose Cone onto one end of each Channel Extrusion with the Slot Nuts running into the T-Track of the Channel Extrusion. Ensure Channel ends are pressed tight against the Reel Box and Nose Cone before tightening bolts. Tighten pre-assembled slot hardware with 4mm Hex Key.






#### Install the Universal Mounting Brackets

Install a Universal Mount into bottom T-Track on each Channel Extrusion. Leave loose until mounted onto raft frame crossbars.

▲ DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN OR DAMAGE WILL OCCUR




#### Join the Channel Extrusions




With the Universal Mounts pre-attached, now connect the two Channel Extrusion halves together with the Channel Connector. Center Channel Connector on the seam. Tighten pre-assembled slot hardware with 4mm Hex Key.


#### Mount SWIFTCAST Rod Holder onto raft frame

Secure the main portion of each Universal Mount around each frame cross bar, then slide the Swiftcast Rod Holder into your preferred position. Once positioned, fully tighten all bolts on the Universal Mount with 4mm hex key. A DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN OR DAMAGE WILL OCCUR



#### Attach Curved Tubes and Pipe Clips

Once the rod holder is fully secured to the raft frame, install both 24in Curved Tubes. Slide tube 1 onto the end of the Nose Cone and secure it with a Pipe Clip. Then slide tube 2 onto the end of tube 1 and secure it with a Pipe Clip. Finally, install the Tube Cap on the end of tube 2. Twist tubes until they match the shape of your raft. You can use the Molle to secure the tube to the raft by securing the velcro strap around the tube and attaching the Molle to an existing tie down strap/webbing



## MAINTENANCE AND USE

- Swiftcast Rod Holder should be cleaned regularly with mild soap and water for maximum longevity.
- Always travel with rod fully rigged in Swiftcast Rod Holder.
- Periodically inspect Swiftcast Rod Holder and frame for damage. Replace lost, damaged, or worn parts with original replacement parts from Riversmith.
- Any modifications made to theSwiftcast Rod Holder or repairs made with parts other than those supplied by the manufacturer will void warranty and liability.

#### SAFETY INFORMATION

- Improperly secured loads and incorrectly mounted rod holders or accessories can come loose causing damage to property, serious injury, or death.
- Always place Universal Mounting Barckets as far apart as possible before securing the Swiftcast Rod Holder.
- · Check all rack and accessory hardware:
  - · Before any trips
  - · After a short drive or float following initial install
  - · At regular intervals during use
  - Anytime rough terrain is encountered on the road or the river
- · Do not use more than one rod in a Swiftcast Rod Holder.
- Do not attach unauthorized accessories to Swiftcast Rod Holder
- Do not step on any part of the Swiftcast Rod Holder when entering or exiting the raft.
