This Limited Warranty covers BajaRack products and all accessories for a period of 2 years from the date of purchase to the original owner of the product and does not apply once the equipment is sold or transferred to another person.

This Warranty does not cover the cost of removal of reinstallation or the product. BajaRack warrants (subject to conditions listed in this warranty) all products to be free of manufacturing defects in materials and workmanship.

## Warranty claim requirements

You will need it if you want to make a warranty claim in the future. Any cost incurred to transport the defective product "to and from" will be the customer's responsibility.



## Warranty resolution

Subject to BajaRack inspection of the product, the company will remedy defects in materials and/or workmanship by repairing or replacing, at BajaRack's option, the defective product without charge for parts or labor, subject to the limitations and exclusions described in this warranty. 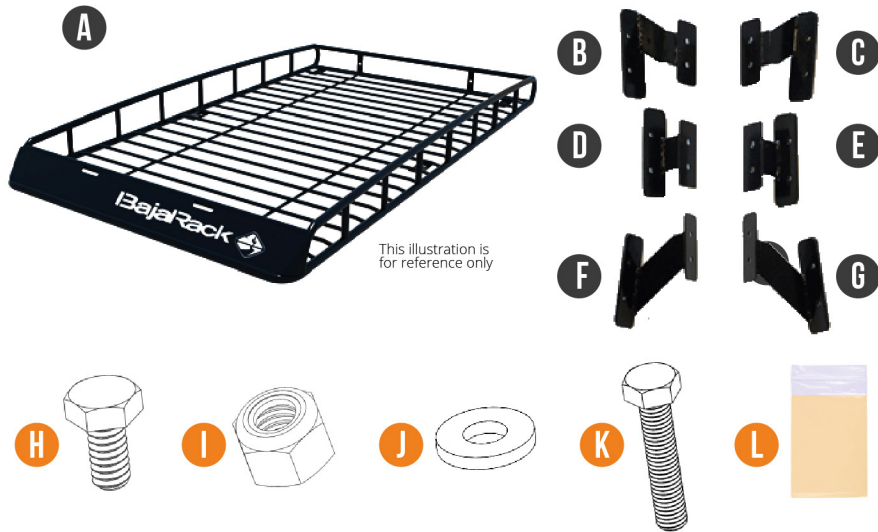

# RACK COMPONENTS



- A) Rack (1x)

## What's in the box

- J) 5/16" X0.75" OD Flat Washer Stainless Steel (36x)
- K) M8-1.25 x 40mm Hex Cap Screw Stainless Steel (12x)
- L) Grease, for use with all bolts with lock nuts (1x)

### Recommended Tools

- 1/2" wrench for installation
- 1/2" ratchet tool for support
- 13mm metric wrench for roof brackets installation
- RTV Silicone sealant

### Tips and recommendations (please read)

- Please Install your rack with the help of a friend.
- The load limit of your rack is 300lb, please do not exceed.
- Your Rack is an accessory; it is not protection for rollovers

# INSTALLATION STEPS

**1** Remove plastic covers (6) located on top of roof with a small flat screw driver. First push cover to the right and then use the screw driver to push out. There should be 2 bolts per cover. Fig. 1

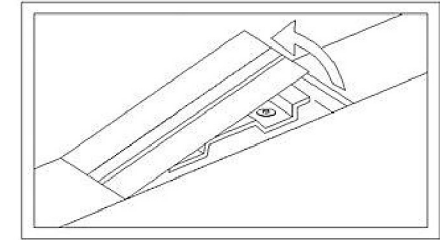

**2** First, loosen all 12 factory bolts (A, figure 2) before removing them completely. Take care not to push downward to prevent pushing the threaded inserts into headliner. You may leave retainers in place if good contact remains.

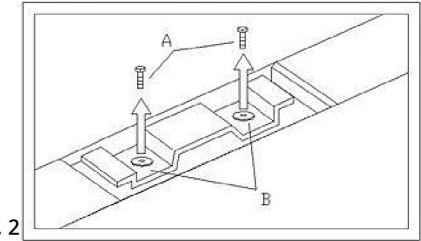

**Note:** It is recommended to apply RTV SILICONE SEALANT in the gap between the roof hole and the insert sleeve (white plastic) and to the threads of all 12 roof (new) bolts. Do not apply too much because it may 'dam' water causing water to pool and enter headliner/vehicle.

**3** Identify all 6 roof brackets (B to G) and place one by one on the roof of the vehicle. **See figure 3 for location of brackets. Note orientation - all point inboard (figs 3 & 4).** Once you have it in place peel the label off. Fig.4. **It is recommended to apply RTV silicone sealant in gap around tubes to prevent leaking.**

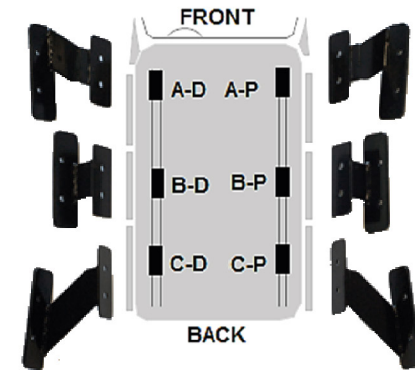

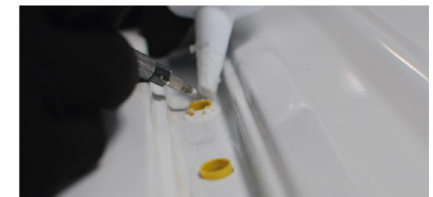

## INSTALLATION STEPS

- 4** To install all 6 brackets you will need 12 washers (I), 12 bolts (K) and a ratchet tool with a 13mm socket ("metric" - remember it's a Japanese car). If you don't have 13mm, try ½".

**NOTE:** Apply RTV SILICONE SEALANT to the threads of all 12 roof (K) bolts. Don't tighten bolts completely, you will need some leeway when aligning the roof brackets with the rack plates.

- 5** Once all 6 roof brackets are in place and secured, place the rack (with the help of another person - "friend") on top of the roof brackets aligning the rack plates with the brackets. Make sure the bottom wind deflector goes under the top of the front A-D and A-P roof brackets (Fig. 7 & 8).

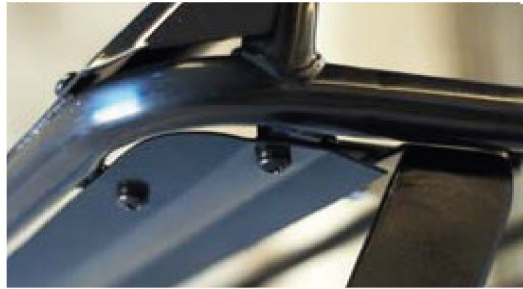

- 6** Pass bolts (H), thru washer (I), thru rack plate and roof bracket, then thru second washer (I). Apply grease (L) to bolt threads (H) and place locknut (J) and tighten using a 1/2" wrench and ratchet tool with 1/2" die. Please use grease (L) before tightening bolts and nuts.

## INSTALLATION STEPS

- 7** Once the rack is in place and attached to roof brackets, you can tighten all 12 roof bolts (K) to the recommended factory torque 18.0 N-m (160 lb-in or 13.3 lb-ft).

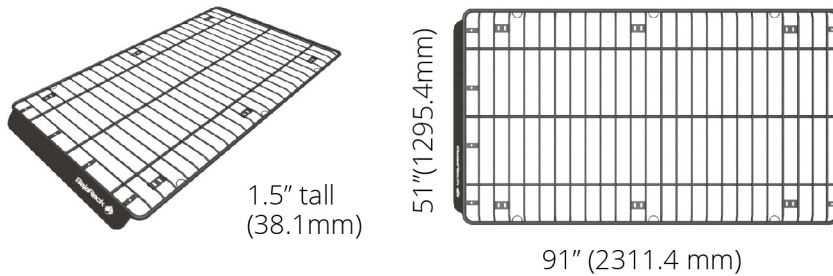

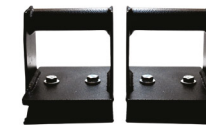
