After two decades as vigneron, Pascal Redon and his wife, Pascale, passed the estate to their eldest sons Adrien and Hugo. With Hugo's behind-the-scenes help in the vineyard and in the production house, head vigneron Adrien crafts his own unique style of Champagne. His low-dosage cuvées highlight the extraordinary chardonnay grapes born of the area's beautiful chalky soil.

Un R d'Autrefois Extra Brut

- SEE** Lemon-yellow with light green reflections and a delicate, active mousse
- SMELL** Honey, citrus and fresh-churned butter, plus summer strawberry thanks to the presence of pinot noir
- TASTE** A beautiful balance of acid and fruit with a faint kiss of sherry. Low dosage lets the grapes shine and leads to a distinctly dry finish.
- PAIR** These bubbles shine on their own, but for a next-level, very French experience, pair them with a freshly baked baguette smeared with sweet butter, sliced breakfast radish and a flurry of Maldon salt.
