LATEX GASKET ATTACHMENT GUIDE

Replacing deteriorated or torn gaskets yourself saves you time and money and is a very useful skill to have. Follow these simple steps to ensure a secure and watertight seal.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Replacement Latex Gasket
- Latex glue
- Sharp Scissors
- Cylindrical Support (e.g., small bucket or bottle)
- Sandpaper (fine grit)
- Alcohol solution or acetone
- Clean Cloth
- Hairdryer



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STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

1. PREPARE THE OLD GASKET:

- Use sharp scissors to carefully cut away the old gasket.
- Leave approximately 2.5 to 3 centimeters of the old gasket in place. This is where you will apply the glue.

2. SMOOTH OUT WRINKLES:

- Position the drysuit onto a cylindrical object to stretch out the remaining gasket.
- Ensure that the surface is smooth and wrinkle-free.

3. CREATE A ROUGH SURFACE:

- Lightly sand the designated gluing area on both the new gasket and the remaining portion of the old gasket.
- This roughened surface will help the adhesive bond more effectively.

4. CLEAN THE SURFACES:

- Wipe down both sanded areas with a cloth dampened with an alcohol solution or acetone.
- The cleaning process is crucial for removing any debris or oils that could interfere with the glue.

5. APPLY THE ADHESIVE:

- Apply a thin, even layer of the glue to both prepared areas.
- Make sure to cover the entire surface intended for bonding.

6. DRYING TIME:

- Allow the glue to set for approximately 40 minutes before attaching the two sides together.
- Do not touch or move the gasket during this time to ensure optimal adhesion.

7. ATTACH THE CUFF:

- Carefully align and press the glued areas of the new gasket with the old gasket.
- Use a hairdryer to apply heat evenly around the gasket as you press together.
- The heat will activate the glue further, creating a strong bond.



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IMPORTANT TIPS:

- Keep the drysuit stretched and wrinkle-free throughout the entire process.
- Avoid applying too much glue, which can create an uneven surface and weaken the seal.
- Always work in a well-ventilated area when handling adhesives and keep it out of reach from children. This is very important.
