



TIPS FOR MEASURING RING SIZE

MEASURING YOUR FINGER

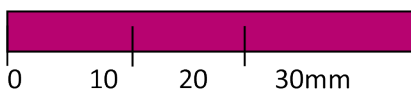
Your ring should fit your finger comfortably; snug enough so that it will not fall off, but loose enough to slide over your knuckle.

Finger size changes depending on the time of day the weather. For best results measure your finger size:

1. At the end of the day when your fingers are warm (Fingers are smaller in the early morning and when cold).
2. Measure finger size 3 to 4 times to eliminate an erroneous reading.

Avoid using string or paper to measure ring size as these materials can stretch or twist, yielding an inaccurate measurement.

HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

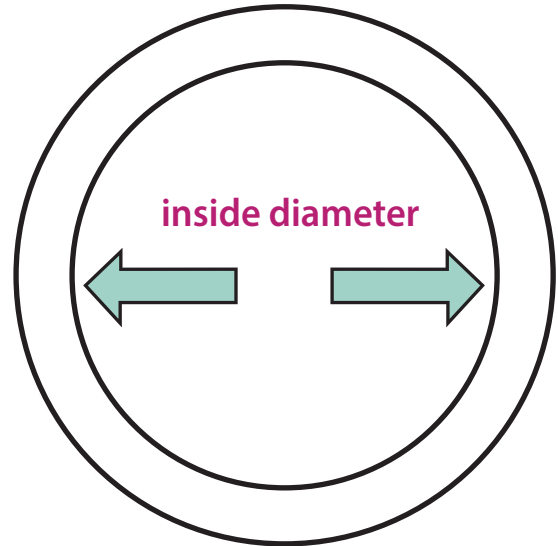


1. Ring measurements are very precise. Carefully follow these instructions to obtain an accurate measurement.
2. Prior to printing, ensure that page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box (To open the print dialog box press CTRL+P).
3. Measure the bar on the left. It must be exactly 30 mm long.



MEASURE CURRENT RING

1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the inside **diameter** of the ring.
3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
