



## Wolfman Kiowa Heat Shield Mounting Instructions

The Kiowa heat shield is designed to protect the Saddle Bag and the plastic side panel from touching the Exhaust. A properly mounted Kiowa Heat Shield. (Shown on Yamaha WR250R)



- 1-Clean Exhaust Pipe on bike.
- 2-Set your –Wolfman Enduro Dry/Ultra-lite, E-12, or Day Tripper Saddle Bags, on your bike as you would to go riding. Mark the area with tape where the bags get the closest to the exhaust pipe. This may include an area **Under** the plastic side panel. The Kiowa heat shield is designed to protect the Saddle Bag and the plastic side panel from touching the Exhaust.
- 3-Thread Screw Clamp through the two oval slots on the side of the Heat Shield.
- 4- Place Heat Shield on the outside of the exhaust centered at your tape marks.
- 5- Thread the loose end through screw mechanism and tighten snug.
- 6-Either Trim Excess Clamp or fold out of the way. 7-Make sure the Clamp does not get near the tire.

**\*\*\*\*\*Please Note-DRZ 400 (S, SM, & E), DR650SE Owners, and others, The Exhaust Side Panel is Flimsy and Not Strong enough to carry much weight. Make Sure you place the Heat Shield under the Side Panel to prevent THIS!!** **Wolfman Luggage will not be held liable for Melted side Panels, Bags and Contents.**
