

**Teacher Talking Points:** These are simple suggestions to help guide the conversation. As always, you are the leader and must discern how to best encourage the children God has placed in your ministry.

- What is a father? What is a father supposed to do? Possible Answers: The male parent
   His job is to love, teach, and protect his children. The special love of a father can help children understand the special love of God for his children.
- 2. How can a good father be a blessing? **Possible Answers:** God wants dads to be a guide and good example to their children. Your father can tell you about Jesus and teach you to follow God's Word.
- 3. Are there any perfect Father's on Earth? **Possible Answers:** No all fall short of our perfect Father in Heaven.
- 4. In what ways is God the best father possible? **Possible Answers**: God is always patient, kind, and strong to protect us in every situation. His guidance and rules in the Bible help us to live well and find salvation in Jesus Christ.
- 5. What other "father figures" has God put in your life? **Possible Answers:** Grandparents, teachers, pastors, business leaders, older brothers, uncles. I.E. positive male role models who can help children understand the fatherly love of God.

## Some Scriptures for Discussion

- Proverbs 23:24-25 (Demonstrating wisdom makes parents proud)
- Matthew 10:26-33 (God provides for insignificant birds; how much more for people?!)
- Matthew 7:11 (God knows what we need and will make sure we have the essentials)
- Luke 15:11-32 (The story of the Prodigal Son; God values each and every one of us; nothing that we do will ever take that away or separate us from His unfailing love)
- Romans 8:14-17 (God adopts us as heirs of His kingdom; He invites us to call Him "Abba")
- Exodus 20:12 (Honor fathers and mothers, and so receive blessing for all of life)

Whichever passage or story you choose to focus on, emphasize how great God's love is for us. We can be assured that, just as our earthly fathers want what is best for us, God does too, and loves us even more than our earthly dads. If we don't know our own dads well, we can take heart in the assurance that God perfectly loves us and desires our love. He makes no mistakes, and He will never abandon us or forsake us.
