

## MagLiner: USER GUIDE

<b>Product</b>	<b>MagLiner - magnetic wallpaper, high receptivity</b>
<b>Description</b>	<b>MagLiner has a high receptivity rating so works with both MagPlus and MagLite magnet types. MagLiner is a versatile matt grey liner with features and finishing options that include:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- easy to hang with multiple configurations</li><li>- finish option a: use the grey finish plain</li><li>- finish option b: use under wallpaper, digital print or fabric</li><li>- finish option c: use under dry-erase or chalk adhesive laminate</li><li>- finish option d: use with all-purpose primer for paint finishes</li><li>- finish option e: use with MagPrint to boost receptivity</li><li>- finish option f: use with MagPaintable to boost receptivity</li></ul>

<b>Maintenance:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- clean using a damp micro fibre cloth</li><li>- if used in an area of strong sunlight move magnets regularly to avoid discolouring</li></ul>
<b>Magnet Usage:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- MagLiner has high receptivity so works with all magnet types</li><li>- MagPlus are high power neodymium magnets for holding items</li><li>- MagLite are low power sheet magnets for placement use</li></ul>
<b>Health and Safety:</b>	Warning - high power magnets can be dangerous if ingested and should not be used by children, always read safety information provided.
<b>Classification:</b>	This product is classified as non-hazardous and therefore does not require any special handling. This product does not require special labelling.
<b>Fire Fighting:</b>	Any extinguishing media are suitable. Wear self contained breathing apparatus, protective clothing and full face mask. Fumes should be ventilated immediately due to possible liberation of noxious gases.

## MagLiner: DECORATOR GUIDE

### Configuration

MagLiner Wallcoverings may be hung in any of the configurations shown above.

### Tools:

- A felt or sponge roller for paste application
- Scissors or sharp blade knife
- Straight edge
- Soft wallpaper brush
- Microfibre cloth or sponge

### Wall preparation:

- ensure the plaster wall surface is clean, dry, sound, mirror smooth and free of paint or chemicals
- best results will be obtained if the base plaster is sealed with a PVA sealer
- where necessary fill holes with filler and use fine sandpaper to smooth

### Hanging guide:

- allow wallcoverings to adjust to room temperature
- cut wallcovering into required lengths
- ensure wallcoverings are hung using MagFix or any high quality ready mixed adhesive.
- pour adhesive into a pasting tray and using a roller apply paste evenly to the wall (soaking is not necessary) cover an area to allow for 1-2 drops (allow 5-7 mins for adhesive to become tacky)
- apply the cut lengths, edge to edge, vertically or horizontally as required
- apply MagLiner to the wall (shiny side to face the wall)
- use a soft clean wallpaper brush or microfibre cloth to flush out air bubbles and creases
- use masking tape to secure if likely to slip during install
- use a straight edge and sharp trimming knife at corners
- do not puncture air bubbles and do not use metal or sharp objects (other than the cutting knife) on the surface when installing the material
- remove any excess paste with a damp sponge and wipe surface clean
- leave to dry thoroughly (min 24 hrs)

### Finishing options:

#### Wallcovering:

- hang wallcovering or digital print on top following recommended guide

#### Laminates:

- for dry erase or chalk laminate, carefully peel one corner back and apply to the wall in the correct position
- slowly peel backing sheet away as you apply the material, flushing air bubbles and creases as you go

#### Paint:

- apply all-purpose primer (Zinsser) allow to dry and then overpaint with any emulsion

#### Removal:

- gently strip away from wall using a scraper
- MagLiner will retain its receptive quality so may be re-used if undamaged on removal
