To set the time

Pull crown gently to position 2. Turn crown to set the hands to desired time. Push crown back to position 0.

To fully wind

The watch can be winded by turning the crown 40 times and by wrist movement it maintains the charge. When it's not worn the charge will last for a maximum of 48 hours.

To set the calendar

(Only available in RIM Sport Monza Collection, not in RIM Sport)

Pull the crown gently to position 1. Turn the crown upwards to desired date. Push crown back to position 0.



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


