

– THE **OUTDOOR** PLUS –
Step by Step Concrete Repair Manual

With this packet, you will receive One jar of you specified Concrete Mix

Materials Needed:

Concrete Mix (Just Add Water)

Soft Brush Plastic Spatula or Putty Knife

Clean Cloth Water



STEP 1: Clean surface of the damaged area by removing any loose material such as dirt, oil or grease and any loose of flaking cement pieces.

Remove and fine dust from the surface with a soft brush or damp rag.



STEP 2: Thoroughly mix concrete mix as particles may have settled or separated during transport.

(Mix should be lump free, putty consistency)



STEP 3: With a plastic putty knife, apply concrete mix to damaged area. Apply enough pressure to fill in any gaps and to prevent air bubbles beneath the surface. (metal tools may damage and scratch the surface of the unit)



STEP 4: Once filled, remove excess concrete and smooth out to match the shape of the unit.
As concrete begins to dry, you will be able to finely smooth it down, getting a more accurate, matching form.



STEP 5: To remove excess concrete, with a damp sponge or rag, firmly wipe away the surrounding area, avoiding the newly filled area.

Step 6: Let concrete dry for at least one hour.
