
Remove the protective film from all panels, and lay panels on a flat surface according to the configuration you choose.




Cap nuts are used for the top two rows, standard nuts are used for the lower two rows. Assemble all straight panels. First, attach all bolts and nuts loosely, then tighten using the wrench or with a screwdriver and cordless drill.




Make sure to tighten each nut and bolt to support the raised garden bed.



After straight panels are assembled, attach corner panels to straight panels using the same method. Make sure corner panels are attached outside of the straight panels.



Push the safety edging along the top rolled steel edge, and cut the extra length off.
