

# **Sublimation Acrylic Paint Directions**

## **Tools You Will Need**

- Paint Brushes
- Water
- Non-porous surface to mix your paint on
- Artesprix Color Mixing Chart

## **Directions**

- 1. Start by shaking the sublimation acrylic paint bottles to ensure a homogenous mixture.
- 2. Mix the colors you would like to use on a non-porous surface.
- 3. Paint on plain paper. Keep in mind any text will need to be mirrored.
- 4. Allow paint to dry on paper before transfer.
- 5. Transfer according to the specifications associated with your sublimation blank, different sublimation materials require different transfer time, temperatures, and pressure settings. Refer to Artesprix blank instructions for transfer specifications.
- 6. Clean brushes with soap and water.

- White Acrylic Lighting Medium for Sublimation will not transfer. Use this in conjunction with the other four colors to create any color.


