

Directions

1. Remove lid from Sublimation Stamp Pad.
2. Use Iron-on-Ink with rubber stamps, polymer cling stamps, and other paper crafting tools.
3. Design on Plain Copy Paper.
4. Clean stamps and stencils with Artesprix Multi-Purpose Cleaner after each use.
5. Replace the lid on the Sublimation Stamp Pad once you are finished.
6. Once your design is complete you are ready to transfer.
7. Transfer according to the specifications associated with your sublimation blank, different sublimation materials require different transfer time, temperatures, and pressure settings. Refer to Artesprix blank instructions for transfer specifications.
8. After your design has been transferred to a compatible sublimation blank it is permanent for a lifetime.

Caring for your stamps:

- Clean your stamps immediately after use with Artesprix Multi-Purpose Cleaner. Discoloration from inks is normal and does not affect stamp performance.

Pro Tips:

- Incorporate the Artesprix Mirror Stamp Plate if using any stamps with text.
- If adding heavy ink to your design, consider using card stock or mixed media paper.
- There is no time limit on your Iron-on-Ink design, you can transfer at your convenience, you do not need to transfer immediately.
