length appr. 160 cm,

width 115 cm from peak to peak or 90 cm at the narrowest point

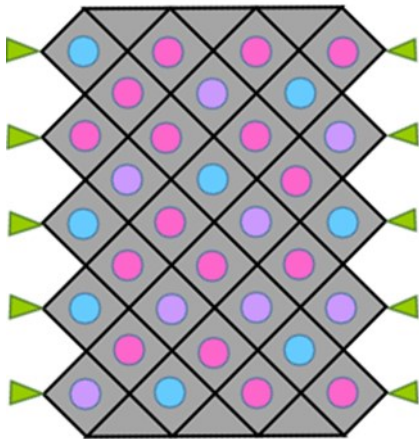
weight appr. 1500 g

The model blanket consists of

- 16 flower squares in different shades of red
- 8 flower squares in different shades of blue and
- 8 flower squares in different shades of purple,

a total of 32 flower squares plus 6 half square triangles, joining, border and decorative tassels.

You have the option to resize the blanket by making more or less squares or by rotating the squares by 45 degrees. Please note, that all changes may have an effect on the square and yarn amounts.

TOOLS

Crochet hooks: Clover Armour 3.5 mm for the squares and 3.0 mm for joining or according to your crocheting to achieve the gauge. With a different gauge, you will also need more or less yarn than estimated.

Needle for waving in the yarn ends. Blocking boards and stainless steel needles for blocking the finished blanket.

MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Merino extrafine 120 yarn in 50 gr yarn balls:

- 2 x tearose (136)
- 2 x kardinal (140)
- 1 x mint (167)
- 1 x capri (168)
- 1 x wisteria (145)
- 1 x violet (147)
- 4 x vihreää (174)
- 21 x harmaata (198)

There is not much extra yarn in the total amount of the yarn. Please pay attention to the gauge, not only in the beginning but also along the project, to make sure you will not run out of yarn. I have also noticed that the blanket is quite heavy. If you crochet fewer stitches per cm than the gauge, there is risk that the blanket will stretch and lose its shape.
