

1: Glue together shown pieces for the posts under the bottom of the building. (4x2)


















2 B: Cut the bottom diagonally on the chimneys front side. (Yellow










4: Glue together shown pieces for the stairs.






5: Glue together shown pieces for the roof.



6: Glue chimney on to the roof.







7: Glue together shown pieces for the wooden barrack.


















9: Glue stairs onto the front of the building.









OPTIONAL: If you want the barracks to look more like a Pacific Island wooden jungle hut, then follow these instructions to alter the look of the roof.



1: Cover the hole in the roof for the chimney with a piece of tape.

2: Smear the roof with PVA glue.



3. Sprinkle on fine sand.



4. When dry, paint it in kakhi, army green and brown colours. Let paint dry, and add PVA glue on various parts of the roof, and then sprinkle on static grass, and let it dry.
