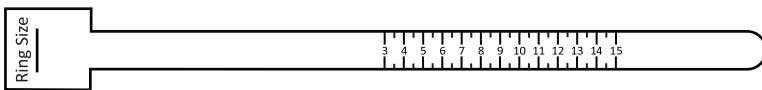


With your printer set to 100%, the bar below should measure 3 inches (7,62cm)



OPTION 1 : THE PAPER METHOD

- Carefully cut out the paper ring guide.
- Make a slit on the line labeled "Ring size".
- Wrap the sizer around the knuckle (or widest part) of the intended finger with the numbers facing out.
- Pull the pointed end until the sizer is snugly fit around the knuckle of your widest part of your intended finger.
- The number closest to the "Ring size" slits the correct size

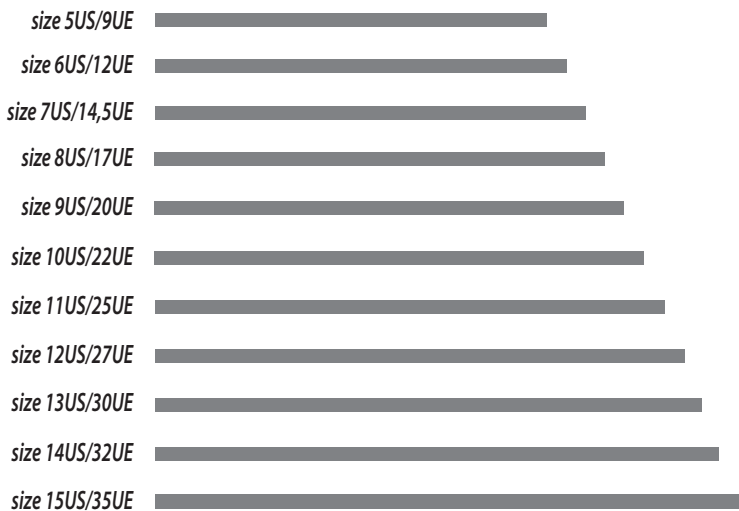


TIPS:

Avoid measuring cold fingers as this is when fingers are at the smallest.
Measure your fingers when it is at its largest, at the end of the day.

OPTION 2 : THE STRING METHOD

- Find a 6" non-stretchy string, or a strip of paper about 6" long and 1/4" wide.
- Wrap the string or paper snugly around the base of your finger.
- Use a pen to mark the point where the string or paper overlaps.
- Lay the marked paper or string flat on the paper below to determine your ring size.
- If the mark is between sizes, order the larger size.



For french sizes, add 40 to UE sizes (30UE size is 70 french size)

OPTION 3 : THE RING METHOD

Take a ring that already fits the desired finger, position it over the circles below until it matches the inside edge of the ring. If the ring's falls between two sizes, choose the larger size.
