### **Care & Maintenance**

#### **CANOPY CARE INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Simply clean the parasol canopy with a soft brush and mild detergent.
- Do not machine wash.
- Do not iron.
- Air-dry the canopy thoroughly before storing for extended periods of time. Make sure the canopy is completely open during drying process to prevent shrinkage.
- If the painted finish gets chipped or scratched, therefore exposing the bare material beneath. It is advisable to remove any surface rust and treat with a suitable touch up paint.
- If the parasol is not to be used for long periods during the winter, store inside or under a suitable cover. Before putting into storage, ensure all of the items are clean and dry.

### DANGER: Keep children out of the assembly area during assembly.

**WARNING**: Read the entire instructions before beginning and follow the steps outlined. Failure to assemble and install as instructed could result in the parasol tipping over causing personal injury and/or property damage.






