Polar Bear Splash Knit Fingerless Mitts

Materials:

Needles: Size US 6 or 4 mm straight

Yarn: Hazel Knits Lively DK or 150 yds of DK superwash wool.

Gauge: 28 sts and 28 rows = 4" across wave stitch

Measurements: Mitt circumference should be size M=6.5"(L=8.25")

Stitch Patterns:

1x1 Ribbing: Row 1-K1. P1

Row 2-K1. P1

Wave Cable:

1R-knit

2W-purl

3R-sl next 2 st to cn and hold in back, k2, k2 from cn, k3


4W-purl

5R-knit

6W-purl

7R-k2, $sl\ 2\ st\ to\ cn\ and\ hold\ in\ front,\ k2,\ k2\ from\ cn,\ k1$

8W-purl





cable 4 left-slide 2 st to cable needle held in front, knit next 2 st, knit 2 st held on cable needle

cable 4 right-slide 2 st to cable needle held in back, knit next 2 st, knit 2 st held on cable needle

Cast on 46(58) Stitches

Work 1x1 ribbing as follows

RS Row-K2, (K1, P1) repeat until one stitch remains, K1

WS Row-P2, (K1, P1) repeat until one stitch remains, P1

Continue until fabric measures .75", finish with a WS row

Work Wave Cable Section

RS row-K2, work wave cable stitch across next 46(58) stitches, K2

WS row-P2, work wave cable stitch across next 46(58) stitches, P2

Work until fabric measures 6.25" from cast on edge

Work 1x1 ribbing

RS Row-K2, (K1, P1) repeat until one stitch remains, K1

WS Row-P2, (K1, P1) repeat until one stitch remains, P1

Continue with .75" of ribbing until fabric measures 7" total

Bind off in pattern

Finishing:

Wet block

Use mattress stitch to seam side.

Seam 2" from bottom, leave 2 inches open for thumb, seam 3 inches from top.
