TZINGANA IGT Colli della Toscana Centrale Red Wine


Tzingana is intensely fruity, balanced with very elegant tannins. It is a Bordeaux blend consisting of Merlot (45%), Cabernet Sauvignon (20%), Cabernet Franc (20%) and Petit Verdot (15%) grapes. The co-fermentation of the four varieties ensures greater complexity and integration. Following the natural fermentation in steel vats, the wine is racked off into French oak barrels where malolactic fermentation takes place. The wine is aged in a combination of barrique and tonneaux for at least 18 months and then aged in bottle for another 6 months.

A full-bodied, fruity, complex and smooth wine. Its tannins, acidity and cherry aroma are unmistakably Tuscan, complemented by fresh cassis, blackberry and a typical Bordeaux-like minerality. This wine can be laid down and enjoyed in years to come, and it is enjoyable from the moment it is released.
