- 2 Find a piece of fabric, t-shirt or towel to work on before laying out all the components, to prevent the components from rolling around.









Make a double knot using the ends of the cords.

Attach one of the Little Mermaid themed charms to decorate the bracelet.





Make a simple knot with all the ends of the cords.



Start making a standard braid until you reach 2 ½ in (6.5 cm) of length.





Thread the gold bead (E) onto all the cords and push it close to the first knot.




Thread a gold bead (A) onto the middle cord of the braid and braid 2 cords together.

TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:

ADHESIVE TAPE CLEAR NAIL POLISH SCISSORS

CONTRACTOR OF THE POLISH SCISSORS

Attach the length of cord (13 in / 33 cm) to your working surface with a piece of tape.

Thread the beads on the cord following the sequence shown.





Thread a gold bead (A) onto the middle cord of the braid and braid 2 cords together.












Thread a gold bead (A) every time you braid 2 cords together until you have threaded 30 of them.




Make 3 square knots and thread 10 gold beads (C) onto the middle cord.





TIP USE A PIECE OF TAPE TO STICK THE MIDDLE CORD TO YOUR WORKING SURFACE.

Pass the ends of cord through the gold bead (E) in the opposite direction.
