Netanyahu scores victory in Israel; blow to Obama

JERUSALEM — Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu was poised for a stunning come-from-behind election victory today as the preliminary count put his Likud Party well ahead of its nearest rivals in a result likely to

further strain relations with Palestinians — and President Obama.
With around 70 percent of votes counted, Likud had 23.73 percent, and the center-left Zionist Union 19.06 percent.
The data represented 29 or 30 seats in the
