- Strong's Concordance: This one can be a little tricky! The first thing you do is look up the word in the main concordance just like a dictionary. Find the reference you are using and look at the number linked to that word. Once you have found the number, look up the number in the Hebrew dictionary in the back. You can also search for where to find words by looking up the word and looking at all the places it is used!
- Bible Dictionary: Use this just like a regular dictionary. Look up the subject - everything is listed in alphabetical order!
