

# HEBREWS 9

Christ as fulfilment of the Day of Atonement

Leviticus Chp 16.	Hebrews Chp 9.
v4. Clothed in linen, symbol of immortality (see Rev 19v7-8)	v12. Eternal redemption (for himself)
17. No man in the Tabernacle (the ritual ceased whilst way into Holiest was made manifest).	v1-10. The ritual of the Law ceased when Christ began his ministry
v16. High Priest makes offering for self	v12. By his own blood he entered in once
v15. High Priest makes offering for the people	v24. Now to appear in the presence of God for us
v14. Blood of sacrifice goes into Holiest of All	v11-14. By his own blood he entered in once to the Most Holy Place
v27. Sacrifices burned without the camp	v13-14. The 3 sacrifices which were burned without the camp. Demonstrating faith in his blood (see Heb 13v11-13)
High Priest comes out of Tabernacle a second time having made an offering for the sins of the people.	v28. We wait for his second appearing to bring forgiveness of sins and salvation

Heb Chp 1. Son of God ordained from foundation of the world

Heb Chp 2. A little lower than the angels for the purpose of suffering

Heb Chp 3. More glory than Moses

Heb Chp 4. Sabbath: Promise of eternal inheritance.

Heb Chp 5. High Priest: To offer both for himself and for the people

Heb Chp 6. Ritual of Law must lead on to completion

Heb Chp 7. Melchizedek: Everlasting Priesthood.

Heb Chp 8. Old covenant to be replaced with new
