It's easy to read because it is the story of what happened to the children of Israel during the time when the Judges ruled.

The Chapters we will be reading are:

Judges 1-9 & 13-18

This workbook will help you to begin studying the Judges.

Remember ~ there is always more to learn!

If you come across something interesting or something that you do not understand, try to learn more about it!

You can always write down any questions that you have and ask someone at Camp. We LOVE to discuss questions at Kids Camp! 😊

Here is what you will need!

Must-have books:

1. King James version of the Bible (The KJV is mandatory, but you might find having other versions helpful)
2. Strong's Concordance
3. Bible Dictionary (We used Unger's and Tyndale's)
4. A Dictionary (Webster's or similar)

2. Dictionary of Biblical Similitudes
3. The Miraculous Significance of Numbers & Colors as They Appear in the Holy Scriptures, by M.D. Stewart



Reminder!!!

The Bible is God's way of talking to us! We have to try our best to listen to what He is telling us and the lessons He is trying to teach us.

How to use Your Tools

The reference books listed above are the tools you will need for your study. Here is a summary of how to use them!

- **Strong's Concordance:** This one can be a little tricky! The first thing you do is look up the word in the main concordance just like a dictionary. Find the reference you are using and look at the number linked to that word. Once you have found the number, look up the number in the Hebrew dictionary in the back. You can also search for where to find words by looking up the word and looking at all the places it is used!
- **Bible Dictionary:** Use this just like a regular dictionary. Look up the subject - everything is listed in alphabetical order!

Time to get started!

- ✓ Always ask Who?, What?, Where?, When?, How?, and Why? when you are reading. Remember to ask questions if you get stuck! Your parents, grandparents, aunts & uncles, or Kids Camp counselors will be happy to help you!
- ✓ Re-read the verses listed above each section before you begin answering the questions! If you do this, it will be much easier. Trying to answer the questions without reading the section is not a good shortcut. It will take you longer, and, more importantly, you won't get as much out of your study!
- ✓ Start early! By starting early and doing a page or two a day, you will be done in plenty of time before Camp. If you wait until the last minute, you will be stuck doing 15 pages a day the last week!
- ✓ There are 5 types of questions in this book:
 - Regular Questions can be answered directly from the passage in front of you.
 - **Look Into It** questions need you to dig a little deeper by using one of the reference books listed on the previous page. You can also ask someone!
 - **Bible Mark It** questions require that you make notes in your margin. You may want to have some sort of lined paper to put behind your page to help you write in a straight line.
 - All you have to do is find the word you are defining, underline it and write the definition on the same line in your margin!
 - **Think About It** questions need some extra thought about the section.
 - **Super Bonus!!!** questions are a little harder to answer because you need to dig deeper into other parts of Scripture or finding out some history. It is usually handy to have your reference books ready for these questions!
