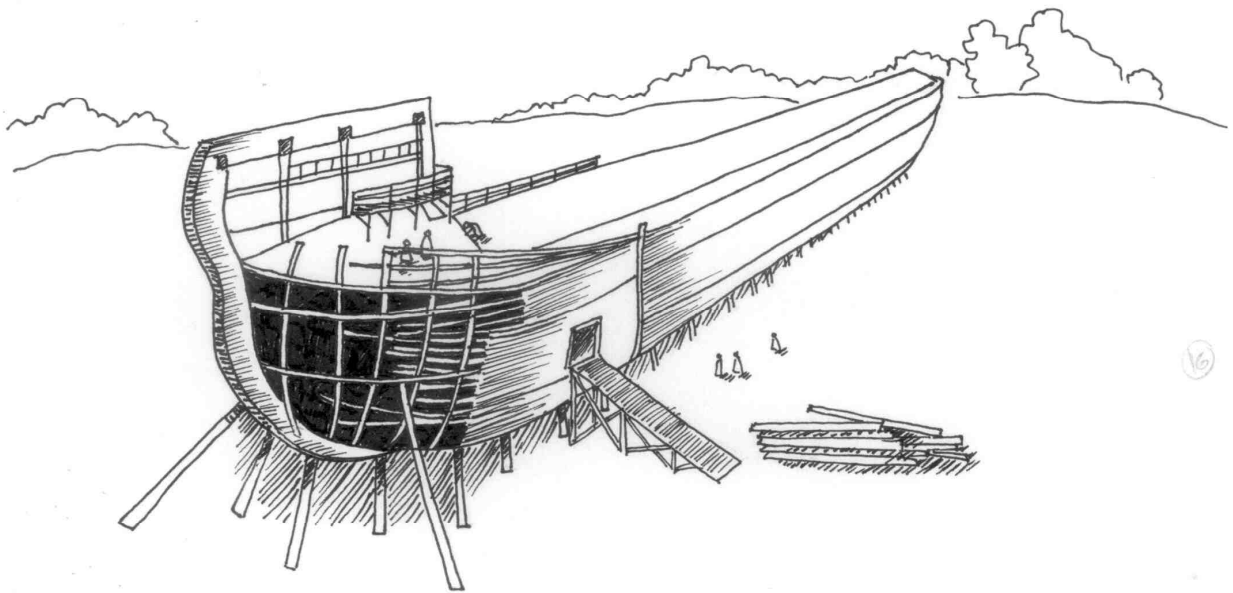

MEMORY VERSES

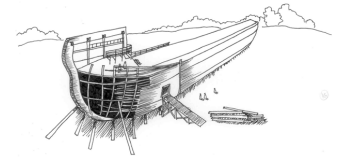
Monday — Hebrews 11:7
