## DIGGING DEEPER \_\_\_\_\_

1. On Sunday we learned about a mom who prayed boldly for her sons. In **Colossians 4:2-4** the Apostle Paul makes a bold declaration about prayer. What specific opportunity did Paul pray for in **verse 3**? Why might some be hesitant to pray this prayer?

Read **Ephesians 6:18-20**. How does this prayer help us overcome some of the excuses we often make for not sharing the gospel?

2. Read **Luke 11:9-13**. What did Jesus say the results of asking, seeking, and knocking would be? Have you had an experience when you have found this to be true?

Is there a condition to this promise? If so, what?

What's the ultimate gift God gives His children, according to **verse 13**?

3. There's nothing greater we can do with our lives than serve God and His mission. Read **2 Corinthians 5:18-21**. What role has He given us (**vs. 20**)?

Why do you think Paul chose this word to describe our role in the world? What's involved in being a quality ambassador?
