# TAKING IT HOME

For the week of June 14, 2020

(Questions and Scriptures for further personal study)

1. **Nehemiah 11-12** features another list of names. Have you ever heard of any of the people in this list before? Why do you think they were included in inspired Scripture if most of them were never mentioned again?

What hope can we glean from this list of basically unknown people? What does this list teach us about the God we serve?

2. Read **Nehemiah 11:1-2**. Why was it so important for the people to move back into Jerusalem? What do you think were some of the difficulties of moving back to Jerusalem?

Why do you think “the people blessed all the men who willingly offered to live in Jerusalem”?

3. What gets in the way of your being willing to move as the Lord leads?

Where is the Lord asking for your willingness? What changes are you afraid of? What do you fear giving up?

4. The story God was writing when He put it in Nehemiah’s heart to rebuild Jerusalem’s walls is a story He continues to write. Read **Hebrews 12:18-24**. What mountain do we now get to approach (v. **22**)? Who is our Mediator there?

Who all is present in the heavenly Jerusalem (vv. **22-24**)?

5. What about the New Jerusalem are you most looking forward to (**Revelation 21:1-7**)?

How does living in the hope of a New Jerusalem change the way you are living your life on earth?
