1. A desperate \_\_\_\_\_ (Luke 8:40-42)

Both had a desperate \_\_\_\_\_ only JESUS could meet.

2. A determined \_\_\_\_\_ (Luke 8:43-48)

# TAKING IT HOME

For the week of June 18.

(Questions and Scriptures for further personal study)

1. **Luke 8:40-56** features two different people facing desperate situations. Can you think of a time you've been desperate for God?

How does the psalmist describe his desperation in **Psalm 69:1-18**?

According to **Psalm 55:22** and **Matthew 11:28-30**, what are we instructed to do when we find ourselves in desperate situations?

2. While Jesus stopped to heal the woman with the blood disorder, Jairus' daughter died. How do you think Jairus felt in that situation? Have you ever questioned God's timing, especially His "delays"?
3. Read the story of Lazarus in **John 11:1-15**. What was the relationship between Jesus and Lazarus? What is surprising about Jesus' response to the sisters' request? Why did Jesus not go immediately (**John 11:4; John 11:14-15**)?

What can we do when it seems God delays in giving His answers?

4. Jairus demonstrated great faith in Jesus. Are you dealing with something right now that you need to take to Jesus?
