



Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need to register for GroupLink?

It's highly recommended as space fills quickly. Registering for GroupLink helps us plan for the event. But if you forget, please still come. We just want you to come and get connected. If you can, let us know you're coming by completing a card or by signing up online at crossroadschristian.org/grouplink.

What if I can't attend GroupLink?

We would love to help you find a group! We'll post a list of groups with openings a couple days after the event. You can find groups that match your stage of life, area of town and is meeting on a night of the week that works for you, and request to join that group. Open group listings are active for about 3 weeks after GroupLink. Openings are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

What is the difference between GroupLink and a Connect Group?

GroupLink is a one-time event where you can find a connect group that works best for you. Connect Groups are small groups of 10-14 people that meet weekly in someone's home for fellowship, Bible study, and prayer. Learn more at crossroadschristian.org/connectgroups

What is a Connector/Assimilator?

Volunteers serve a vital role at each GroupLink event. Connectors/Assimilators are volunteers who help people connect into groups by providing information about Connect Groups. They also attend GroupLink to assist people as they form groups. They will be wearing blue t-shirts at the event.

Childcare will be provided. Please RSVP on the registration form if you need childcare, as space is limited.
